# Policies: FEES and RATES

## REGISTRATION

- Registration Fee and First Month's Tuition Fee due in full at time of registration.
- Registration Fees:

\$35 single student

\$65 family of two

\$80 family of three or more

# TUITION

- Paid monthly, not weekly as amounts would vary.
- Rates determined by the total hours a student is enrolled per week and will not differ in shorter or longer months.
- Tuition covers class enrollment only. Additional fees are associated with performances.
- Full Tuition Scale available on separate page.
- Semi Private and Private Lessons differ.
- Tuition Payment Options: Applies to tuition ONLY

#### One Time Payment CASH or CHECK ONLY

- Balance paid in full at time of registration.
- 10% discount if registered before or at Open House.
- Returned checks will incur a \$35 fee and 10% discount will no longer be available.
- NO REFUNDS

#### **Monthly Payments**

- Auto Pay: charged or debited the 1st of each month.
   Visa or MasterCard accepted.
- Declined transactions will incur a \$15 late fee.
- Students will not be permitted in the classroom if payment has not been received by the 10th of the month.
- Withdrawal Form and Fee REQUIRED to stop auto pay before the end of the full term.
- NO Check or Cash accepted for monthly tuition fees.
- NO REFUNDS

# FAMILY DISCOUNTS

- Family Discount: After first registered student a 10% discount will be applied per student.
- · Unlimited Tuition:

\$375 family of two

\$475 family of three or more

· Discounts available to siblings/parents ONLY.

We reserve the right at all times to change or cancel any classes, days, times, and/or teachers; to provide substitute teachers for any amount of time, and to observe all holidays.

Makeup classes will NOT be scheduled for ALL inclement weather cancellations. No tuition discounts for inclement weather.

No pro-rated tuition for missed classes due to student absences. Students may make up class time by attending a different class in the same age/level when available. Notice MUST be given to desk staff in advance to attend a different class as a make up.

Withdrawal Fee – 1/2 of full months tuition OR \$55 if

month to avoid tuition charges for the next month.

Account holders will be held responsible for ALL
charges posted to accounts prior to withdrawal.

## PERFORMANCE FEES

- Performances are optional unless dancer is a member of Parker Dance Company.
- Performance Fee Rates: \*\* Tentative fees listed due to venue unknowns surrounding COVID-19\*\*
  \$55 per student Winter Extravaganza Includes full media package.

\$175-\$225 per student - The Nutcracker - Includes full media package, tee, costume rentals \$125 per student - Spring Recital - Includes full media package, tee

- Notice of final totals will be given prior to due dates.
- Fees will be automatically charged or debited to the card on file as follows:
- October 15th The Nutcracker (winter show)
- November 1st Winter Extravaganza (winter show)
- May 1st Recital (spring show)
- Students registering AFTER the above dates are required to include payment for Performance Fees with the registration fee and first month's tuition.
- To OPT OUT of performances and avoid Performance Fees we MUST receive the Performance Opt Out Form no later than September 5th for winter shows and no later than January 31 for spring shows.
- NO REFUNDS
- Additional costs apply for: show tickets, Memory Book Ads, recital gifts, flowers, etc.

### COSTUME FEES

- Costume Fees will be charged or debited to the card on file unless a student has completed the OPT OUT process by the designated date. See Performance Fees above.
- Costume Details per show:

#### Winter Extravaganza

- Includes all classes EXCEPT Beginner Ballet Level V Ballet.
- NO CAD costume fee associated.
- Dancers will wear Christmas or Winter inspired pajamas purchased individually.

#### The Nutcracker

- Includes Beginner Ballet Level V Ballet ONLY.
- Costumes are property of CAD and will be loaned to dancers for performances.
- Costume rental fee is included in Performance Fees listed above.

#### Recital

- Costumes are only required for classes that include choreography for shows.
- Costume Fee Rates:

\$75 Classes for ages 18 months-5 years

\$85 Classes for ages 5 years (BEG) and older (INT, ADV, L I - L V, POINTE I - II)

- Costume Fees include: costume, any required alterations, accessories, any extra added embellishments, and tights when applicable. \*NOTE: Tights are NOT included for Beginner Ballet -Level V Ballet or Pointe.
- Costume Fees DO NOT include shoes. Required shoes for all performances will follow the CAD dress code.
- Fees will be charged in two installments for students with more than 3 or more costumes only.

1st Installment - February 1st

2nd Installment - March 1st

Dancers with 1-2 costumes will be charged in full.

One Payment - February 1st

- Students registering AFTER February 15th are required to include payment for all Costume Fees with the registration fee and first month's tuition.
- Students registering AFTER March 15th are NOT guaranteed to perform in the Recital as additional costume orders may not be possible. Shipping fees may be applicable as well.
- NO REFUNDS

- Unlimited Tuition does NOT include: semi private lessons, private lessons, master classes, guest teachers, or special events.
- Example of Family Discount:
- Susie is enrolled in 2 hours of class time per week. Her brother, Sam, is enrolled in 1.5 hours of class time per week. Susie's tuition rate is \$95 per month. Sam receives a 10% discount per month. The original tuition rate for Sam is \$81 per month. His discounted rate is \$72.90 per month. The tuition total for this family would be \$163.90 per month.

# **Policy in the case of mandated shut down:**

- CAD will provide online classes to all registered students.
- Tuition fees will be charged at the normal rates for online classes.
- No refunds or pro-rated tuition rates will be granted in the case of moving to online classes.
- If a student withdraws due to a switch to online classes the withdrawal fee will be 1/2 the normal rate.
- If mandates are lifted and classes resume in studio any student that withdrew will need to re-register. In this case the registration fee will be 1/2 the normal rate.
- Costume and Performance Fees may be pushed back to a later date in the case of unknown dates, venue changes, show details, etc.
- Costume Fees cannot be refunded once they have been paid.
- Performance Fees will be refunded by case basis in terms of the situation surrounding any date changes due to a shut down of venues.

CAD takes pride in teaching life lessons through dance education and providing a dance education that exceeds expectation. Every effort will be made to continue with all classes, shows, etc. in the case of a mandated shut down. This may include but is not limited to date changes, venue changes, online options, outdoor stages, etc. As a small business we strive to bring out of the box ideas to life to ensure great service and follow through for our dancers and their families.
