Steve is a retired Hydraulic Engineer and Engineering Supervisor formerly with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. He also has served as an independent contractor with the Susquehanna River Basin Commission in the field of water resources engineering. Steve's engineering career spanned over 36 years.

Steve and his wife, Janeann, have been married 44 years, and reside in Mechanicsburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. They have two grown children, and four grandchildren. Steve is active in his church and in local historical groups.

Steve has a keen interest in local history, the Revolutionary and Civil War, area canals, coal mining, lumbering and lumber rafting, and Indian tribes that once lived in the Susquehanna Basin. He is here as a volunteer with the Susquehanna River Basin Commission's Public Information and Outreach Program to discuss today's topic.

September 13: Tavern Dinner at the mansion at 5: 30 PM


