We do not have a facility for animal intake, however we can assist you with courtesy postings on several sites as long as you or a designate foster the animal you wish to rehome. If for some reason the animal is returned for any reason, they are to be returned to you or your designate until another home can be found. At no point are we accepting ownership/possession of this animal. Our function is to serve as an animal welfare liaison enabling you to find the animal you are helping a home, whether is is your own or a stray. If you decide to adopt the animal yourself then you will be required to pay 50% of the funding used for veterinary/medical costs that was used to help/benefit said animal.
