The Special Meeting of the Bailey Town Board was held in the Bailey Town Hall on November 26, 2018 at 6:30 pm.

The following members of the Bailey Town Board were present: Mayor Thomas Richards, Mayor Pro Temp Dwan Finch, Commissioners Allen Daniels, Joel Killion, Shelley Bullard and Town Administrator Timothy Johnson. Commissioner Jerry Bisette was absent from the meeting.

Called the meeting to order:

Mayor Richards apologized for the delay in getting the meeting started and then called the meeting to order.

Agenda items:


A motion was made to officially bring Gerald Coggin on as of November 26, 2018 as Interim Part-Time Police Chief for administrative duties, for hiring consultant, and working Chief duties upon his swearing in by Commissioner Killion and seconded by Commissioner Finch and was passed by the following: Commissioners Daniels, Finch, and Killion in the affirmative. Commissioner Bullard voting against. Commissioner Bisette was not present to vote. (3 affirm); (1 nay)

A motion was made to have Chief Coggin post a Full-Time Police Chief, Full-Time Officer, and Part-Time Officer on the North Carolina League of Municipalities website by Commissioner Killion and seconded by Commissioner Daniel and was unanimously passed. (4 affirm); (0 nay)

A question was asked by citizen Paulette Umstead about if the Police Department had anything in writing regarding Rules of Order or Rules of Conduct for police officers in town. Chief Coggin did state that the Bailey Police Department did have a Standard Operating Procedures manual that did cover this topic in place.

Adjournment:

There being no further business, Commissioner Daniels made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Finch seconded the motion and the motion unanimously passed. (4 affirm); (0 nays)
