### 4th Sunday of Easter 2022

Last week we had First Communion for students in Scoil Bríd. Congratulations to the Communicants and to their families - a great occasion for the parish.

One of the great Catholic magazines is The Tablet, and I have used it as a source for these notes. Their 30 April issue remembered a former editor (1982 to 2003), John Wilkins, who died last month. The Second Vatican Council which had

closed in 1965 had left many loose ends still untied. Pope John Paul II's wanted to close down the discussion on issues such as female ordination, homosexuality, abortion, contraception and the admission of divorced and remarried Catholics to Holy Communion. He issued definitive answers

and made assent to them a test of Catholic orthodoxy. Wilkins had grave misgivings, he wanted to keep the debate open. There were periodic bouts of conflict as senior

Catholic leaders took their cue from Rome's inflexible line. Wilkin's technique was to accept the inevitability of the occasional yellow card but to avoid being shown the red one!

He said that is no far as he was in opposition to the papacy of the time, it was always a "loyal opposition".

The Tablet was famous as a breath of Catholic fresh air and for its excellent writing.

The Church and The Tablet owe him an immeasurable debt.
