The Ten Commandments

Exodus Chapter 20; Deuteronomy Chapter 5

Yahweh Called Moses to the top of Mount Sinai and gave him two tablets of testimony, tablets of stone, written by the finger of Elohim.

1. I am Yahweh your Elohim, who has brought you out from the land of Egypt and the house of bondage. You shall not have any other Elohim before My face.

2. You shall not make a graven image for yourself, or any likeness in the heavens above, or in the earth beneath or in the waters under the earth; you shall not bow to them, and you shall not serve them; for I am Yahweh your Elohim, a jealous El, visiting the iniquity of fathers on sons, on third and on the fourth generation, to those that hate me; and doing kindness to thousands, to those loving Me, and to those keeping My commandments.

3. You shall not take the name of Yahweh your Elohim in vain; for Yahweh will not leave unpunished the one who take His name in vain.

4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy; six days you shall labor and do all your work; and the seventh day is a Sabbath to YAHWEH your Elohim; you shall not do any work, you, and your son, and your daughter, your male slave and your slave-girl, and your livestock, and your stranger who is in your gates. For in six days YAHWEH made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all which is in them, and He rested on the seventh day; on account of this YAHWEH blessed the Sabbath day and sanctified it.

5. Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long on the land which YAHWEH your Elohim is giving to you.

6. You shall not murder.

7. You shall not commit adultery.

8. You shall not steal.


9. You shall not testify a witness of falsehood against your neighbor.

10. You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his male slave, or his slave-girl, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything which belongs to your neighbor.


