**Target REDcard** - sign up for this credit or debit card and 1% of all of your purchases will go to Coyote Ridge (and you receive 5% off of all of your purchases)! Visit target.com/redcard to apply and then be sure to visit target. com/tcoe to designate your school as Coyote Ridge.

**Amazon.com** - there are two ways to earn money for the school via amazon. com. The preferred way is through the eScrip site. To do this, you need to access amazon.com through the escrip.com web site. Sign in to your eScrip, account, click on "At the Online Mall" and then click on the Amazon link. eScrip will donate 2.4% of your purchases to the school. The other way is through Amazon Smile. Visit http:// smile.amazon.com/ch/04-3672762 and sign up for Amazon Smile. Designate Coyote Ridge as your school, and Amazon will automatically donate 0.5% of your purchases.

**Shoparoo** - download the Shoparoo App on your iPhone or Android and designate Coyote Ridge as your school (use the code "creft138" to earn points for the school when you join). To participate in Shoparoo, all you have to do is snap photos of your store receipts and the school gets money. I have been using this app for about a year now and have not had any problems with privacy issues. It is actually a little addictive! We have earned over \$150 using this app. Coyote Ridge currently has 39 supporters and about five people that use it regularly - imagine how much we could earn if we could get more supporters!

Save Mart/FoodMaxx - use your store loyalty card and earn 3% on qualified purchases back to the school! You don't even need to register this card. Cards are available for pick up at the front office or contact Cheryl (daxsmama@hotmail.com) and she will get you one.

#### **Stride Rite and Pediped Shoes**
