#### Transfers Interstate Permanent Transfer Interstate Temporary Transfer Intrastate – within WA (Refer Rule 2 page 34 rule book)

# Please ensure members are aware of the requirements for a transfer or being a borrowed player.

#### **Interstate Transfer**

A player transferring permanently from one state to another must complete the PAA form **Player transfer Version 2 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2012 PAA** this is located on the PAA website and the PAWA website. It is the transferring player's responsibility to have this completed and approved at least 7 days prior to the carnival being played with the new club.

For players entering WA there may be a fee payable to the PAWA prior to playing. Please check this fee with the host state if transferring to another state from WA.

## Interstate Temporary Transfer

A player wishing to travel interstate and play more than 2 carnivals or for a specific time frame must complete the PAA form **Temporary Player Transfer Version 2 June 2012** this is located on the PAA website and the PAWA website. It is the transferring player's responsibility to have this completed and approved at least 7 days prior to the carnival being played with the new club.

For players entering WA on this transfer there is a fee of \$110 payable to the PAWA prior to playing. Please check this fee with the host state if transferring to another state from WA.

#### Intrastate – within WA

A player wishing to transfer from one club to another within the state of WA must complete the PAWA form **PAWA Intrastate Transfer** which is located on the PAWA website.

This form will be passed onto the State Chief Umpire. **Once approval is granted (by the State Chief Umpire) there is a 7 day waiting period before you can play for the new club.** It is the transferring player's responsibility to have this completed and approved at least 7 days prior to the carnival being played with the new club. (Refer rule 2 page 34)

## **Borrowed player**

If you are playing for any club other than the one you are registered with you must obtain a letter (email) from that club stating they give you permission to play for "xxxxxx" club at "xxxxxx" tournament. This letter (email) must be in the hands of the State Secretary on the Thursday prior to the tournament

## State Championships

It is a by-law of the Association that clubs do not borrow players at this tournament. In a selection year it is acceptable for juniors and intermediates to be borrowed players within their zones. If you have extra players their names will be taken at the time teams are nominated and these individuals will be pooled, the State will endeavor to find games for the extra players.
