Conditions and Entry Rules: The Cust Domain is a public facility. At any time, members of the public may come through the grounds and there may be dogs present. It is your responsibility to keep yourself and your horse safe and your horse under control at all times.

Please read the following rules and ensure all people with you are familiar with them. All Competitors and Visitors, enter the grounds at their own risk.

- 1. Our main Aim, is to have Fun !**
- 2. NO** plaiting in any section.
- 3. ALL MANURE AND HAY MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FLOAT PARKING AREA.**
- Entry fees **MUST** accompany entries and paid in full. Failure to do this, will result in no entry.
- English / Western and Stock attire accepted in all classes. Tidy attire and covered shoes are to be worn.
- HORSES AGE: Horses age is to be as of when entries close 23rd July 2021. * This is different from previous years due to this years' show being held on the 1st August. This was decided by the committee.**
- Cust Equestrian Group, the Cust Doman Board and the Waimakariri District Council will not be held accountable for any loss, theft or damage to any property.
- All colts over the age of 6 months, must be handled by a person aged 18 years and over.
- Ribbons 1st – 6th are awarded at the discretion of the judge. The judge's decision is final. Champion and Reserve Champion sashes in ALL Sections.
- Class may be deleted or combined at the organiser's discretion
- Horses/Ponies may compete in one section only.
- Due to limited parking space, entries are limited to 180 exhibits.
- Bits are not mandatory and are to be used with discretion on any horse/pony under the age of 3 years.
- Cust Equestrian Group will NOT tolerate any miss treatment of whips or other forms of abusive behaviour or manner towards any horse/pony. Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification.
- Please, no dogs to be brought to the show.
- Entry Fee \$7.50 per class/per horse. Catalogue \$2.
- Ground Fee – CEG members free, Non Members \$5 per horse/pony
- Back number issued if required, but exhibitors may use their own number holder.
- Entries Close Friday 16th July 2021. NO LATE ENTRIES will be accepted.
