

# Miracles of Yahshua

The gospels record thirty-five separate miracles performed by Yahshua. Matthew mentions twenty of them; Mark mentions eighteen; Luke mentions twenty; and John mentions seven. These, however are not all of the miracles that Yahshua performed. Matthew, for instances, mentions twelve occasions when Yahshua performed a number of wonderful works (4:23-24; 8:16; 9:35; 10:1,8; 11:4-5; 11:20-34; 12:15; 14:14; 14:36; 15:30; 19:2; 21:14).

## Why the Miracles of Yahshua?

1. Yahshua heals because He's asked to.

2. Yahweh does miracles in order to teach us.

3. Yahweh does miracles to bring people to salvation.

4. Miracles open doors to bringing the good news message of the Kingdom of Yahweh.

5. Yahshua himself appealed directly to the authenticating value of His miracles.

7. Yahweh heals for sovereign purposes, (simply because He wants to).
