Driving directions to the park entrance: (97 miles – about 1 hour and 45 minutes)



- 1. Take US-75 south to I-30
- 2. Merge onto I-30 W via EXIT 284A
- 3. Take EXIT 44B for I-35E toward Waco (for ~5 miles)
- 4. Split from I-35E onto US-67 S (toward Cleburne for ~70 miles)
- 5. After you enter and begin to leave Glen Rose, turn right on FM-205 (for ~3 miles)
- 6. At "Dinosaur World", take a right onto Park Rd 59

NOTE: If you wish to visit Dinosaur World, you can either arrive early Friday or visit

FEES

\$15/family/tent, plus (optionally) \$6/person for Dinosaur World (Payable to Pack 516) \$5/day per person 13 and older. Children under 12 are free! (Park entrance fee)

Camping fees are due by Tuesday, March 22nd (pack meeting). Commitment and number of people camping due Sunday, March 13th.

WHAT TO BRING

The following are some helpful suggestions of things to bring camping:

Tent + Tarp (in case it rains)

Sleeping bag

Lantern/flashlights + extra batteries

Clothes (plus extra), including Class A Uniform

Shoes that can get WET (in the river)

Fishing gear (but basic gear will be provided)

Pocket knife

Bicycles/helmet (optional if you wish to ride)

Camp chairs

Cooking/Eating gear, utensils, and soap

Water bottles, for the hikes

Trash bags

GPS (for Geocaching)

Toiletries, sunscreen, insect repellant, hat

Food (to bring)

- Dinner for Friday night
- Breakfast for Saturday and Sunday
- Lunch for Saturday
- Lunch for Sunday (if staying for Dino World)
- Drinks, plenty of water!
