We will have a traditional Ash Wednesday service on March 2 at 7:00 pm with the imposition of the ashes saved from the Palms of last year's Palm Sunday service. However, instead of services the remaining Wednesday nights during Lent we are going to do a Lenten Meditation and Study after services on Sunday. Depending on how many attend we will have it in Luther Hall or the beautiful newly painted downstairs conference room.
