## Mark's Thoughts

### You Count!

As youngsters my siblings and I would count the presents under the tree. If one didn't count a new one slipped under the tree could get overlooked and thus not fantasized about.

Counting has always been a part of the Christmas celebration beginning with Christmas I. Luke 2:1 *In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world.*

The census was for tax purposes; revenue for the Roman empire. It served a secondary purpose as well. Bethlehem was to be the birthplace of the Messiah but Mary & Joseph were in Nazareth. Something extraordinary would be required to get an 8 months pregnant Mary to Bethlehem. The government was good then as now at getting people to do things they would rather not. Rome wants to count its empire so Mary & Joseph go to Bethlehem and the rest as we know is history. History that is related to the idea of counting.

You and I count with God, in fact the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem bears witness to that very truth. Galatians 4:4-5. *4 But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, 5 to redeem those under the law, that we might receive adoption to sonship.*

You and I and everyone count with God. So instead of letting us languish in our sins, he sent his Son to bear the punishment for sin in our place. Because of this, my sins are not counted against me. *"I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.* Jeremiah 31:34b

### COLLECTING SHOES



The LWML Oklahoma District is conducting a **Shoe Collection Drive** till Jan. 30, 2017, to raise funds for missions and helping others in third world countries. We will earn funds based on the number of pairs collected so begin by checking your closets, your family and even your neighbors. All shoes need to be clean and in good condition. We ask that they be **NEW, USED OR GENTLY WORN**. Here are some helpful hints: Laced shoes, just tie the laces together in pairs. Non-lace shoes, band together in pairs by using rubber bands. Shoes acceptable include boots, heeled shoes, tennis shoes, golf shoes, flip flops, and children shoes. These shoes will be sent to third world countries to support micro-enterprise vendors. (These are small businesses in these developing countries such as Haiti, Honduras & other nations in Central America & Africa.) Shoes not acceptable are roller skates and ice skates. Several 33-gallon trash bags marked with a picture of a red tennis shoe reading will be near the Coffee-Donut table in the narthex along with sturdy rubber bands to tie the shoes together. We have a short window of opportunity here so start collecting your shoes and bring them anytime to church and place in the marked bags. **Help Raise Funds for LWML**. ## Lions and Tigers and Bears

During the month of December, <FISH><, *Friends Into Serving Him*, will be collecting **stuffed animals, new baseball caps, journals, school supplies, coloring books, crayons, stickers, books, puzzles, diapers (size 1,2,4,5), wipes, games and pens** for the Child Abuse Network (CAN). These items are given to every child that this organization helps. CAN exists to reduce the trauma that a child abuse investigation can pose for a child. Before the CAN program came into being, children frequently endured stressful exams and numerous interviews by various agencies, often in cold, sterile facilities. Now, CAN provides one central location where the professionals come to the children. The centralized approach reduces the number of times children must repeat their story and helps them begin their healing process faster. At CAN each child is given a stuffed animal or another items of their choosing to help ease their anxieties, since they often arrive without anything.
