

# Folkestone and Hythe Birds

Tetrad Guide: TR13 H


(West Hythe, Hythe Roughs West, Lympne and Folks' Wood)



## Introduction

The Royal Military Canal runs along the southern edge of the tetrad TR13 H, from just east of the West Hythe Dam (in TR13 C) eastwards almost to the Burmarsh Bridge at Palmarsh. To the north lies Lympne Park Wood on a section of the limestone escarpment that also contains the western part of Hythe Roughs, whilst inland of the escarpment Folks' Wood, the village of Lympne, and surrounding farmland can be found.

## Habitats and birds

The Royal Military Canal and its banks form one of the most interesting habitats. The canal itself holds breeding Mute Swan, Moorhen and possibly Coot, whilst Reed Warblers breed in the *Phragmites* and the scrub and trees which line the bank have breeding Cetti's Warbler and Bullfinch amongst the commoner species. Kingfishers are regularly seen and may breed on occasion. It is a reliable site in winter for finding Chiffchaff, Blackcap and Firecrest.

Rarer visitors have included Mandarin Duck, Garganey, Goldeneye, Smew, Goosander, Grey Phalarope, Red-throated Diver and a presumed escaped Falcated Duck. The Green Heron that spent three weeks in TR13 C in autumn 2008 ventured into the tetrad on at least one occasion, and the Night Heron present in late autumn/winter of the same year did so several times, whilst a Bittern was seen along the canal by Hythe Roughs, to the west of the Palmarsh estate, in February 1982 and a Squacco Heron flew over in June 2007.

The drain that runs parallel to the northern bank of the canal often attracts Water Rail, particularly adjacent to the small reedbed between West Hythe and Palmarsh, whilst the Alder trees here may hold Siskin and Lesser Redpoll in winter. To the north of the canal the land climbs steeply up until it meets the Aldington Road.

This escarpment is of Kentish ragstone, a hard sandy limestone formed by the Hythe Beds of the Lower Greensand, which produces calcareous soils, and contains part of the Lympne Escarpment SSSI. The grassland and woodland of this site are among the best remaining examples of semi-natural habitats on ragstone in Kent (English Nature 1981).

Lympne Park Wood is the largest remaining example of ash coppice woodland on the ragstone escarpment. It is thought to be of ancient origin with a long history of woodland cover. It is best known ornithologically for its herony, known since at least 1937, which held 38 nests at its peak in 1971, with around ten nests in recent years. Little Egrets have been sighted in the wood on a couple of occasions, raising hopes that they might also breed here in future.

A pair of Hobbies have been found to have nested annually in recent years, whilst typical woodland species such as Tawny Owl, Stock Dove, Great Spotted Woodpecker, Jay, Marsh Tit, Long-tailed Tit, Goldcrest, Nuthatch and Treecreeper also breed, whilst Lesser Spotted Woodpecker, Willow Tit, Spotted Flycatcher, Nightingale and Tree Sparrow formerly did. In the 1950s there were records of Wryneck and Hoopoe, and it seems likely that the former may have bred in the area, and possibly even the latter.

The wood traditionally held the largest local rookery, with between 100 and 150 pairs in the early 1980s, and 110 pairs still present in 2003 but numbers then declined to just eight pairs in 2021 and none were present in 2022. The reasons for the decline are unknown. Elsewhere in the tetrad there are also rookeries at Shepway Cross (up to 30 nests) and at Berwick House (up to 56 nests).

Much of the escarpment is open grassland, forming the western section of Hythe Roughs, and provides ideal habitat for Green Woodpecker, Kestrel and Little Owl, whilst the scrub holds breeding Lesser Whitethroat, Whitethroat, Stonechat, Linnet and Yellowhammer, having also attracted Ring Ouzel on passage. This was one of last strongholds of Turtle Dove locally but this species has disappeared in the last few years.

The plateau either side of the roman road, known as Aldington Road or the Old London Road, is farmland which can attract winter thrushes or flocks of Skylarks, Meadow Pipits, Linnets, Chaffinches, Yellowhammers and Reed Buntings, particularly if some stubble or fallow areas are left. In winter 2020/2021 for example an area record flock of up to 300 Linnets frequented a crop field near Oathill Cottages. Lapwing and Snipe (with up to 62 of the latter present in February 2017) have also been recorded, with Merlin on occasion, whilst Red-legged Partridges may also be found. Wheatears are frequent on passage.

Folks' Wood holds breeding Buzzard, Tawny Owl, Marsh Tit, Nuthatch and possibly Garden Warbler, and wintering Woodcock, whilst a small pond in the wood (adjacent to the A261) often holds Mandarin Duck, with a peak count of 27 there in January 2013. A Golden Oriole was recorded in May 1985.

Gardens in Lympne village have produced Black Redstart, Brambling and also Waxwings during irruption years (most recently in December 2010), with White Stork, Great White Egret, Short-eared Owl and Crossbill noted flying over, whilst in March 2021 a flock of six Barnacle and 27 White-fronted Geese were seen in a field just to the north.

The tetrad has produced a number of other migrants including Pied Flycatcher, Redstart, Whinchat, Grasshopper Warbler, Barred Warbler, Icterine Warbler, Marsh Warbler and Hawfinch.

Raptors noted overhead have included Osprey, Honey Buzzard, Marsh Harrier, Red Kite and Rough-legged Buzzard.

### Access and parking

There is a pay and display car park at West Hythe, just to the north of the road bridge over the canal at the base of Lympne Hill (for current charges refer to: [www.folkestone-hythe.gov.uk/parking/car-parks](http://www.folkestone-hythe.gov.uk/parking/car-parks)). This provides a convenient base for exploring the canal by means of the footpaths that run along both banks and there are crossing points to the west at West Hythe Dam (in TR13 C) and to the east at Burmarsh Bridge, Palmash (in TR13 M), which enable a different return route to be taken.

There is no public access to Lympne Park Wood but the herony is viewable from the north bank of the canal to the west of West Hythe.

Hythe Roughs is owned by the Ministry of Defence and has permissive access, so it is possible to cover most of the site although one could be asked to leave should military activity be taking place.

There is a well-marked path which runs from the gate near the Burmarsh Bridge uphill across Hythe Roughs to the acoustic mirror, which is not marked on the map, neither are the several other smaller paths. The ground off the beaten tracks however is uneven, boggy and overgrown in places so care should be taken here. There is also a path which runs from Hythe to Lympne along the top of Hythe Roughs, following the edge of the greensand “cliff”, which affords good views of Hythe Roughs and the marsh beyond.

There is a bridleway that passes through Folks' Wood (although comes to a dead end at the A261). The Saxon Shore Way and other footpaths shown on the map permit views to the adjacent farmland.

### Bird species diversity

A total of 66 breeding species were recorded in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork, which ranks as the second richest in diversity amongst the 31 local tetrads as the table below demonstrates. The total of wintering species recorded during the atlas fieldwork was the seventh highest and the overall total species recorded is the 14<sup>th</sup> highest (with a lack of coastline limiting the overall diversity).

### Other Natural History

The southern half of the tetrad contains part of the Lympne Escarpment SSSI, which extends eastwards to the Hythe end of Hythe Roughs. Due to the SSSI designation the fauna and flora here have been well catalogued, and the non-avian lists are amongst some of the most complete in the area.

Hythe Roughs supports the only Kent colony of the Four-spotted moth, whilst moth trapping at West Hythe has been undertaken intermittently since the early 2000s and has produced some very significant records. The first Kent record of *Cosmopterix scribaiella* (New Marsh Cosmet) was trapped there in July 2015, with mines being found along the canal in November 2019, confirming its establishment in the county.

The first local sighting of Scarce Chocolate-tip in over a century was taken there in August 2019, whilst in July 2017 the second modern record of Dark Crimson Underwing occurred. The formerly rare migrants *Catoptria verellus* (Marbled Grass-veneer) and Dusky Hook-tip now appear to be established here.

West Hythe has produced a good variety of other scarce moths including *Pseudopostega crepusculella* (Mint Bent-wing), *Yponomeuta irrorella* (Scarce Ermine), *Luquetia lobella* (Sloe Flat-body), *Gelechia nigra* (Black Groundling), *Pammene suspectana* (Ash-bark Piercer), *Sciota adelphella* (Willow Knot-horn), *Rhodophaea formosa* (Beautiful Knot-horn), Small Scallop, Cream Wave, White-banded Carpet, Sub-angled Wave, Clay Fan-foot, Waved Black, Beautiful Marbled and Shore Wainscot.

Moth trapping has also taken place at Folks' Wood in recent years and produced the first area (and first vice county) record of the adventive *Musotima nitidalis* (Fern China-mark). Other captures of particular note have included *Caloptilia populetorum* (Clouded Slender), *Spatialistis bifasciana* (Small Purple Button), *Pseudosciaphila branderiana* (Great Marble), *Ancylis obtusana* (Small Buckthorn Roller), *Ancylis diminutana* (Small Festooned Roller), Map-winged Swift, Barred Hook-tip, Frosted Green, Yellow Horned, Little Emerald and Olive Crescent.

Folks' Wood is the also only local site where Silver-washed Fritillary and White Admiral butterflies are known to be established.

In August 2017 the first area record of Willow Emerald Damselfly occurred at West Hythe, whilst Banded Demoiselle has also been noted.



The presence of the Marsh Frog, the largest of British frogs, is also notable. It is said to have been introduced in 1935 from Hungary possibly into local garden ponds at Lympne (and at Stone-in-Oxney). It spread very rapidly along the Marsh dykes and by 1940 had reached the western extremity of Romney Marsh at Pett Level, also colonising the Royal Military Canal.

The grassland and woodland on the Lympne Escarpment SSSI are among the best remaining examples of semi-natural habitats on ragstone in Kent. Wet ash-maple is the predominant woodland type with a small area of calcareous ash-wych elm wood, whilst many plants usually associated with chalk soils occur in the grassland. Outcrops of ragstone are frequent on the upper slopes of the escarpment and the vegetation here is dominated by grasses such as fescues, Cock's-foot, False Oat-grass and Tor-grass. Grazing helps to encourage a diverse flowering plant community including Carline Thistle and Hound's-tongue which are associated with calcareous soils.

Due to the high humidity of the south-facing slope wood sedge and stinking iris, species usually restricted to woods, can grow in the open grassland, and these conditions also promote the growth of ferns and mosses. The grasslands have been designated as a Biodiversity Action Plan priority habitat.

Numerous springs and flushes occur at the base of the escarpment at the junction of the ragstone and the Atherfield Clay and the marshy ground below the spring-line has tall herb vegetation including plants such as Great Horsetail, Great Willowherb, Ragged Robin and Water Figwort.

Lympne Park Wood is the largest remaining example of ash coppice woodland on the ragstone escarpment. It is thought to be of ancient origin with a long history of woodland cover. Most of the wood is ash, field-maple and hazel coppice with oak and ash standards, with wych elm present in a small area in the south-east corner. The calcareous nature of the soil is shown by the presence of shrubs such as spindle and wild privet.

Of note elsewhere is a small colony of Lizard Orchids at Pedlinge.

A list of all species recorded in the tetrad is provided below in Appendix 2.

### General History

Following the decline of *Portus Lemanis* (see TR13 C), West Hythe (known at the time as Sandtun or Sandton) hung on as a small port, in spite of the constant threat of its harbour silting up. "A Chapel of Our Lady" (St. Mary's Church) was established there in Norman times, but by now West Hythe was being abandoned by the sea and eventually dwindled away to just a few settlements.

The church was built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century and consisted of a small nave and chancel constructed from rubble with stone dressings. In the early 14<sup>th</sup> century the nave was lengthened, a new chancel arch inserted and a buttress built against the nave. The church was destroyed by fire in 1620 but is listed as a Grade II monument.

*Portus Lemanis* was connected to the Roman road system and the Maidstone to Dover Roman Road (which runs west to east across the centre of the tetrad) crosses the main Canterbury to Lympne road close to Shepway Cross, where a war memorial is now situated. The memorial, which remembers the fallen of the Cinque Ports, dates from August 1923.

The Royal Military Canal, which runs almost along the southern boundary of TR13 H, is a characteristic of a number of local tetrads. The canal is a coastal defence work that was constructed between 1804 and 1809 and its purpose was to separate the expected landing and deployment of Napoleon's troops upon the coast of Romney Marsh from the interior of the country and was the idea of Lt. Col. Brown, the Assistant Quartermaster-General.

The canal runs a total of about 28 miles from Seabrook via Hythe, inland to Appledore, then to join the Eastern River Rother at Iden lock, from where it became part of first the Rother and then the River Brede, turning into a canal again from Winchelsea to Cliff End on the coast. Excavated earth formed the banquette and parapet on the landward side of the canal and behind this was an army supply route, the Royal Military Road. On the opposite side were the tow path and wharves. It also included a back and a front drain.

The canal and parapets were so built that gun positions could be provided at the end of each length to flank the crossings. However, by the time the canal was completed in 1809, the threat of invasion had passed following Napoleon's defeat at the Battle of Trafalgar, and it was to some extent obsolete. In 1810, the canal was opened for public use and tolls were also collected for use of the Royal Military Road. The current West Hythe bridge which spans the canal was opened in 1883.

In 1923 a 20' experimental acoustic mirror was built on Hythe Roughs and a larger 30' mirror was added later just to the west. A forerunner of radar, acoustic mirrors were built on the south and north-east coasts of England between about 1916 and the 1930s. The 'listening ears' were intended to provide early warning of incoming enemy aircraft.

Landslips caused the abandoned smaller mirror to fall on its face, probably sometime in the 1970s. The foundations of huts which once stood near the mirror are still visible. The larger mirror is still standing though is deteriorating. The dish structure is made of metal mesh, supported by an angle-iron frame and covered with concrete, and has a listening chamber underneath. On the slope just below there is another military building, possibly a radio station.

In the north-east of the tetrad a small Anglican church can be found at Pedlinge. This is actually a Chapel of Ease, which is a church building other than the main parish church (Saltwood Church), built within the bounds of a parish for the attendance of those who cannot reach the parish church conveniently.

Sometimes, as is the case here, they are associated with large manor houses (Sandling Park), where they provide a convenient place of worship for the family of the manor, and for the domestic and rural staff of the house and the estate. It was commissioned by Laurence Hardy sometime after 1897 (when the manor house at Sandling passed to him).

Also of note within the tetrad are the Grade II listed residences Berwick House and Little Berwick in Lympne, the latter a timber-framed building dating from the early seventeenth century.




