HOW WE COLLECT AND STORE INFORMATION

We may collect and store personal or other information that you voluntarily supply to us online while using our website through our website platform, Webs.com (i.e. directly signing up or via contact by email to a feature provided on the Site).

We only contact individuals who specifically request that we do so, received a service or attended a class, or in the event that they have signed up online to receive our free newsletters. We collect personally identifying information from our users that includes name and e-mail address for registration to receive our free newsletters and name, postal address, and credit card information when purchasing our products. All of this information is provided to us by you.

WHAT DO WE DO WITH THE INFORMATION

We also collect and store information that is generated automatically as you navigate online through the Site. For example, we may collect, through Webs.com, our website platform, "information about your computer's connection to the Internet, which allows us, among other things, to improve the delivery of our web pages to you and to measure traffic on the Site. We also may use a standard feature found in browser software called a "cookie" to enhance your experience with the Site. Cookies are small files that your web browser places on your hard drive for record-keeping purposes. By Showing how and when visitors use the Site, cookies help us deliver advertisements, identify how many unique users visit us, and track user trends and patterns. They also prevent you from having to re-enter your preferences on certain areas of the Site where you may have entered preference information before. HOW DO WE STORE YOUR INFORMATION?

Your information is stored at the list server of Mail Chimp, that delivers our newsletters. Your information can only be accessed by those who help manage those lists in order to deliver e-mail to those who would like to receive our newsletters.

All medical history forms and follow up session notes are stored in filing cabinets, where only the therapist has direct access. If we have not seen a client in over a 7 year period, we shred all documents.

HOW DO I REQUEST DELETION OF STORED INFORMATION?

For our newsletters, simply go to the bottom and select "unsubscribe." Mail Chimp sends us an email with the notice and they automatically remove your information.

For medical history and follow up session notes, simply contact us directly by phone or email. We will then shred all of your related documents.
