On Saturday, January 30, 2015, child care provider cohort III had a very special visit from Elizabeth Zanetti, who graduated from the second cohort of *Quality Environments in a Family Child Care Setting*.

This is a four-session cohort in which participants explore how to enhance their family child care home through training on the Family Child Care Environmental Rating Scale (FCCERS-R) and review of *Family Child Care Homes: Creative Spaces for Children to Learn* by Linda J. Armstrong. Once participants complete the training they receive individualized technical assistance and are rated using the FCCERS-R.

Zanetti shared how the training has had a positive impact on her program. She has made several changes to her environment, and has added regular communication with parents. Her rating on the FCCERS-R was an average score of 7! We are so proud of her and look forward to seeing her program continue to flourish.
