A receipt will be sent to you shortly after your entry arrives. Please check the details on the receipt carefully. A “not-before” start time will be advised on the receipt but your actual start time is advised on your rally pack and may be later than that. For any special requests for specific start times please send a request with the entry form. Organisers reserve the right to start any vehicle at any time.

Note also that the system checks your financial status so please make sure your VCC subs are paid. Late entries, if accepted, guest riders and unpaid members are not eligible for prizes.

Accommodation

The whole rally is to be held at:
Port Waikato School Camp,
68 Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road,
Port Waikato.

The camp is set in a beautiful semi-bush environment and accommodation** is on site in a variety of combinations. A dormitory bed is naturally the cheapest but couples will be accommodated in own rooms if possible. The twin-bed rooms are already pre-reserved based on our initial request for expressions of interest, but there are a number of single-bed rooms which we would allocate to couples until there are no more. The entry form asks if couples would be willing to share a dormitory should we run out of rooms in which case the price difference will be refunded. If there are no more rooms and you do not want to share in a dorm but you still attend the rally, the cost difference will be refunded. The Dormitories hold 25 people and there are 4 of them so people should be fairly well separated.

**** Unfortunately, there is no bedding supplied other than a mattress protector. Please bring your own bedding.**

The Weekend

It is the 42nd Motorcycle Rally of the Motorcycle section of the Auckland Veteran & Vintage Car Club Inc.

The rally this year is a live-in rally similar to our Orewa rallies except that this year we have booked the PORT WAIKATO SCHOOL CAMP, 68 Port Waikato-Waikaretu Road, Port Waikato as the rally HQ. This is a school camp with sufficient accommodation for all attendees.

The rally begins on Friday at 6pm at the rally HQ. with a pie and pud evening. Your accommodation choice is outlined on the previous page.

The ride: There is a longer ride of about 120 miles and a shorter ride of about 90-100 miles. The plan is to stop at some historical sites significant in our early history.

Start: From the Port Waikato School camp at **9:15am** with **briefing at 9:00am**.

Lunch: Is planned to be at a local school.

Dinner: Will be held at the Rally HQ starting at 6:00PM.

Breakfasts: Are provided, coffee, toast cereal fruit

Covid: If part or all of the rally is cancelled the cost will be refunded. Entrants will be advised of any changes by E-mail.

Entry to the secretary by October 16th 2022.

Please ensure you advise your bank account to facilitate refunds if required.

ENTERING THIS EVENT: Each vehicle may be entered in one class only. A minimum of three entries in each class may be applied for trophies to be awarded. Each competing vehicle must be entered by a financial member of the Vintage Car Club of NZ Inc.
