

37 **Bowling, Annie M.** – In large letters on the top of the stone: MOTHER. On the face of the stone: Annie M. Bowling 1871-1910. (Daughter of Lyman Swartz & Anna Godfrey, wife of George Bowling, cause of death: Septicemia, age 38 Years, 6 Mos, 22 Days).



38 **Swartz, Emma Jane** – Died Dec 30, 1871, 3 Yrs, 1 Mo, 25 Days. (Daughter of Lyman Swartz & Anna Godfrey, cause of death: Smallpox).



39 Swartz, Lyman – A big letterhead “S”, Lyman Swartz, Co. K 22nd Mich Vol Inft, Born Oct 22, 1839, Died Jan 19, 1912. (Son of Sally (Farr) Swartz-Tucker and Elias Swartz, also step-son of John Tucker.)
39 Swartz, Annie M. – Wife of Lyman Swartz, Born March 17, 1848, Died April 1, 1905. On the right hand side of the stone: In the wild woods I have roamed. But now I go to my heavenly home.



Lyman Swartz is a Civil War veteran.

40 Bice, Clara, D – Daughter of Alfred T. Bice & Nancy R. Nichol, Age 11 months.

42 Bradley, William – Co. C. 149th N.Y. Inf. (b. ca. 1821, d. May 15, 1878, son of Charles & Hannan Bradley, husband of Sarah Nesbit, cause of death: consumption – TB)



William Bradley is a Civil War veteran.

43 McGinnis (Smith), Eve – Born ca. 1840, D Oct 30, 1875, daughter of T.M. McGinnis, age 35 Yrs, 2 Mos, 10 Days.



44 Lawther, David – Died Sept 30, 1879, Aged 18 Years. (Born ca. 1861, son of John & Fannie Lawler).

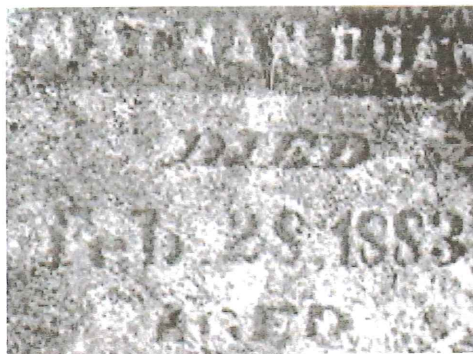


45 Doan, Deborah – Died Feb 1876

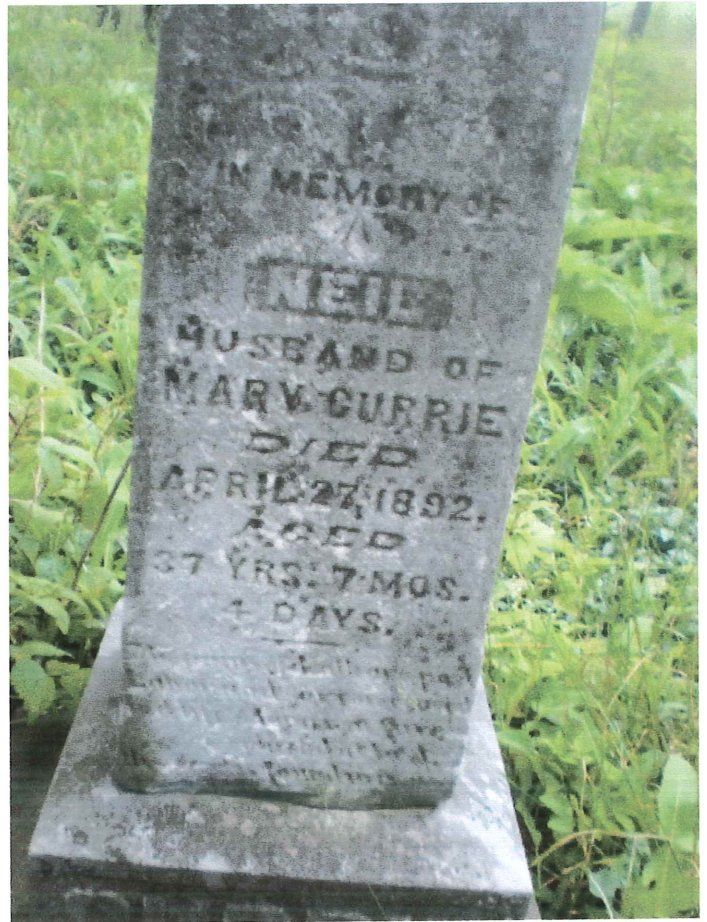
48A Currie, Neil – In Memory of NEIL Husband of Mary Currie, Died April 27, 1892, Aged 37 Yrs, 7 Mos, 4 Days.

Notes:

A. There are two headstones for Neil Curry.

B. They are about 20 feet from each other on the south side of the cemetery.

C. One of them states that he lived 37 Y, 7 M & **4 Days** and the other has him living 37 Y, 7 M & **5 Days** - the second one has him living an extra day.



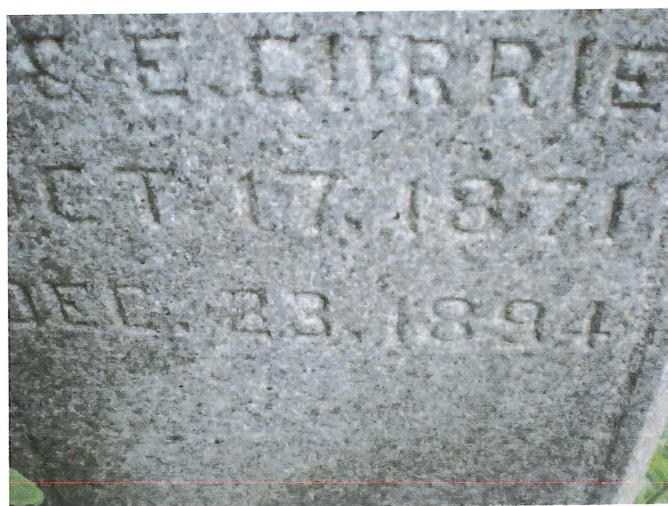
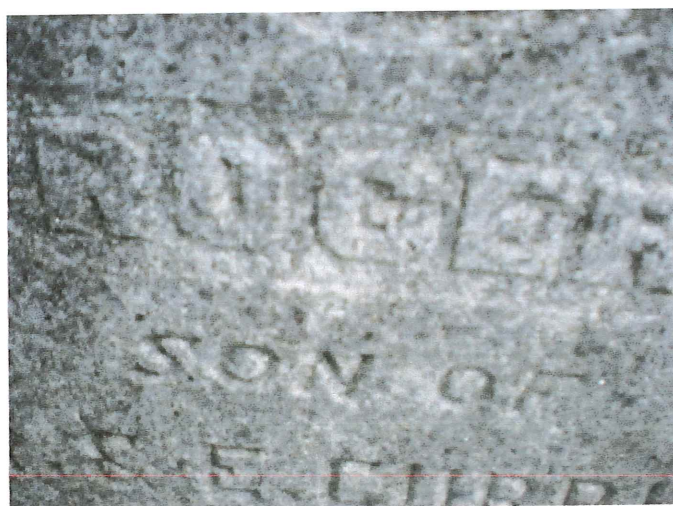
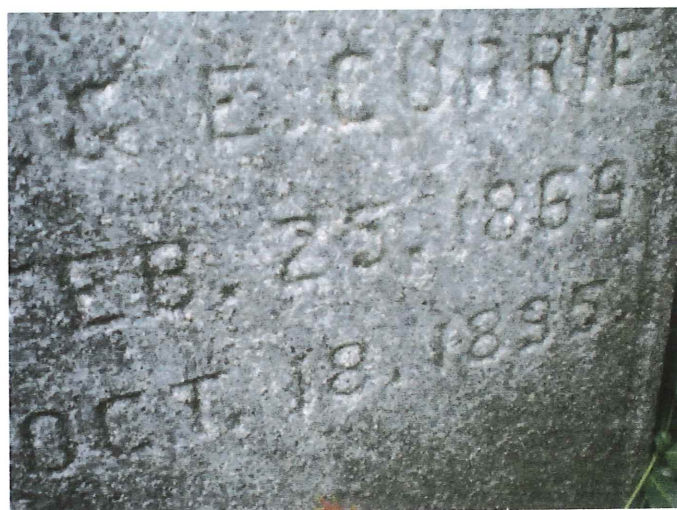
48B Currie, Neil – Died April 27, 1892, Aged 37 Yrs, 7 Mos, 5 Days. At Rest.

This is the second stone for the same person.

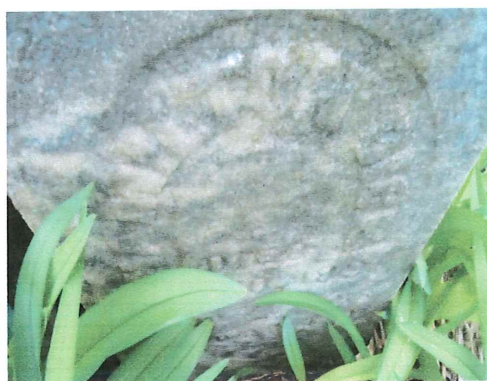
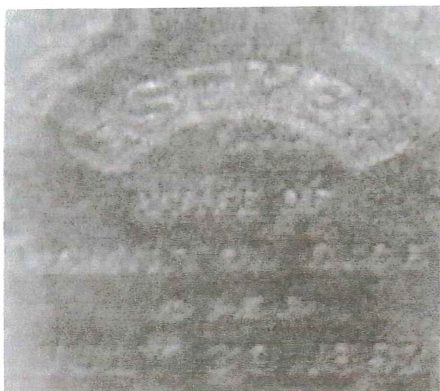

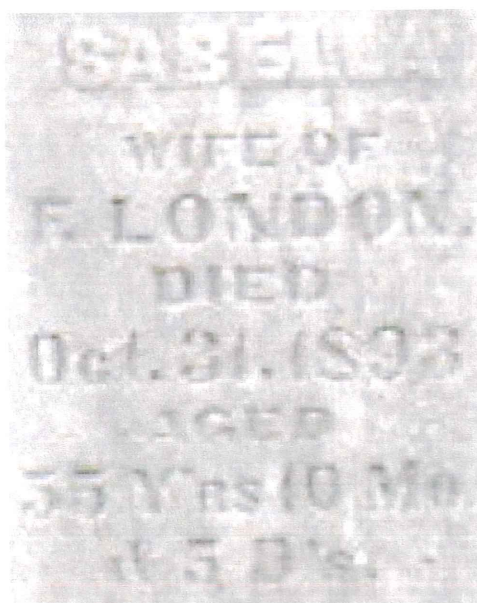
Currie, Roger – Son of R & E Currie, born Oct 17, 1871, died Dec 23, 1894. (Son of Roger & Elizabeth Currie)



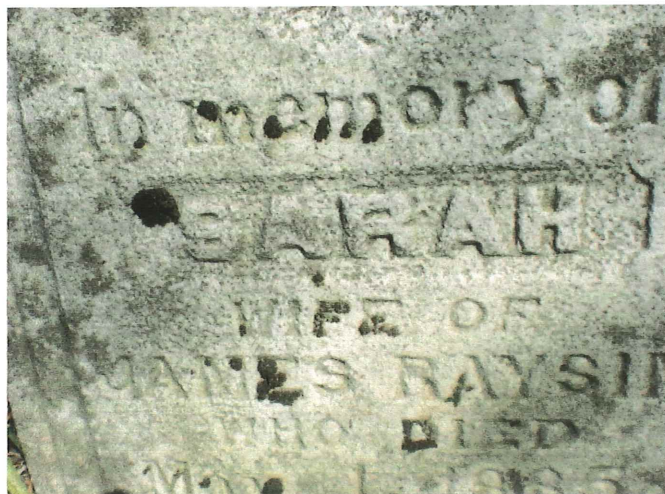
50 **Bice, Esther** – Wife of Hamilton, died July 30, 1887, Aged 76 Yrs, 5 Mos.
Bice, Hamilton – died Feb 10, 1891, Aged 79 Yrs, 7 Mos, 4 Days



51 **London, Isabella** – Wife of F. London, died Oct 31, 1893, Aged 55 Yrs, 10 Mos, 5 Days. (Wife of Frederick London, Daughter of Hamilton Bice & Esther Thompson).



52 Raysin, Sarah – In memory of SARAH, wife of James Raysin, who died May 1, 1885, Aged 85 Years, 7 Months, 25 Days. (Daughter of Samuel & Sarah Hinley)



53 Foster, Elizabeth – In memory of Elizabeth, wife of George Foster (cannot read the rest). (born ca. 1805, d. Dec 1, 1875, cause of death: heart disease).



54 **Nichol, Mattie I** – Dau of Joseph & Martha Nichol, Born Jan 29, 1896, Age 8 Mo & 11 Days. (Daughter of Joseph Nichol and Martha Briggs).



55 **Young, George W** – Son of W. & M. Young, Died June 29, 1885, Aged 3 Mos. 18 D's.
