Psalms 23:6 surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life:

In the face of many obstacles, in the deepest part of the darkest valleys of our life, we can exclaim the Lord's goodness and mercy are upon us. # Time to testify of God's Goodness

## Psalm 145:7 "they will tell about all your goodness"

We often spend several hours telling one another about our hurt, disappointments, sickness, and trouble, than we do telling of God's Goodness. David says, "They will tell about all your goodness." Therefore we must testify of God's Goodness.

What is meant by the phrase God's Goodness, It is "a perfection of His character which He exercises towards His creatures according to the various circumstances and relations (Psalms 145:8, 9: 103:8; 1 John 4:8). Viewed generally, it is benevolence; as exercised with respect to the miseries of His creatures it is mercy, pity, compassion, and in the case of impenitent sinners, long-suffering patience: as exercise in communicating favor on the unworthy it is grace. "Goodness and justice are the several aspect of ones unchangeable infinitely wise and sovereign moral perfection. God is not sometimes merciful and sometime just, but He is eternally infinitely just and merciful." Good is infinitely and unchangeably good (Zephaniah 3:17), and His goodness is incomprehensible by the infinite mind (Romans. 11:35, 36). "God's goodness appears in two things, giving and forgiving. (Easton's Bible Dictionary)

This is the reason I have to testify of His goodness, for He gave me eternal life. He gave me hope when I was hopeless. He fed me many days when I was hungry. Thou open your hand, and satisfy the desires of every living thing" (*Psalm* 145:15, 16). It is a fact God's Goodness is extended to His entire creature, whether it be the birds of the air, the beasts of the forest, or fish in the sea, abundant provision has been made to supply their every need. God "giveth food to all flesh, for His mercy endureth forever" (Psalm 136:25).

I am a walking testimony of the goodness of God. I am reminded in 1990, when I was out of work because of a job related injury and my compensation had ran out and I had to apply for disability. The only income coming in at that time was my husbands. During that time my apartment was destroyed by fire having no money and no where to go, God's goodness provided shelter for me and my family. Soon after that my husband got sick and had to stop working. The only income we had coming in was his disability check from the military. Again we found ourselves in need of a home. God's Goodness supplied all of our needs according to His riches, Philippians 4:19. But His goodness did not stop there. When moving back to Maryland in 1992, one morning after my husband had left to go take care of some business, I began to wash clothes and started praying and praising God as I always do. The Holy Spirit spoke to me and told me to read Deuteronomy 11:11 "But the land, whither ye go to possess it," and these words stood out. I said to myself, "what land?" we don't have any money to purchase land. As soon as those words left my mouth, my husband came in and said, "The Lord told me to go buy a house." Again, I asked my husband how are we going to buy a house, we don't have any money and we both are on disability? He said, "God told me

to do it and I am going to buy a house." That same day he went to Century 21 Real Estate Agency and began looking for the house God showed him, until he found it. I saw my townhouse being built from the ground up. We were short of funds in purchasing the house, God touched the builder's heart and he provided us with what we needed. Truly God had showed me His Goodness over and over again.

I thank God for all the goodness He gave in supplying my needs for the flesh.

But the goodness of God I am most grateful for is when He sent forth His son "born of a women, born under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons" (*Galatians 4:4, 5).* Goodness was the spring of redemption for the Father to give the life of His only son to death upon the cross for the freedom of lost man kind.

His goodness continues today to all that will accept Him. I am willing to testify as David says, of God's Goodness.

I have listened to that voice ever since - ever growing in the knowledge of Jesus Christ. It's been a journey – learning how to surrender all to Jesus. Making miss-steps here and there but the Lord was leading and guiding me back to Him every time. Every step was building my faith. I have received Jesus' healing power in my body because of my belief – several times. Science can not explain away what I know to be true.

One of my most favorite scriptures is Hebrew 11:6 – "But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. " If we don't use our faith we won't have testimonies. We can know for ourselves that God really does exist. Psalm 34:8 states "Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who trusts in Him!" David tasted and he learned to trust God. ### The Grace of God that gave us Life

Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned— <sup>3</sup>for before the law was given, sin was in the world. But sin is not taken into account when there is no law. <sup>14</sup>Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who was a pattern of the one to come.

<sup>15</sup>But the gift is not like the trespass. For if the many died by the trespass of the one man, how much more did God's grace and the gift that came by the grace of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow to the many! <sup>16</sup>Again, the gift of God is not like the result of the one man's sin: the judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation, but the gift followed many trespasses and brought justification.

<sup>17</sup>For if, by the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man, Jesus Christ Romans 5:12-17

When we read this passage we see that it is talking about two men, Adam and Jesus. Adam broke God's commandment and brought sin into the world, which has caused all of us to be born into sin, and by natural instinct to be sinners and die. To do wrong is a part of our DNA because Adam chose to eat of the fruit. But God, and His grace, has offered us a free gift, Jesus Christ. Verse 16 states" *the gift followed many trespasses and brought* 

justification" that makes me shout, HALLELUJAH, THANK YOU LORD JESUS! No matter what we've done, we can be justified. The definition of justified is to declare free of blame, to free (human) of the guilt and penalty attached to a grievous sin. WE'RE SET FREE! Don't hold onto the things of your past. Jesus has come to set you free. Forgive yourself; don't allow Satan to hold you bondage to your past. I am greatly overjoyed in my freedom. I can testify that Jesus has set me free; I don't have to be ashamed of anything I've done, because I'm forgiven. 2 Corinthians 5:17 says

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" I rejoice in my renewal, greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world. I'm not bound by sin and death, I have life more abundantly. Jesus said," I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" [John 14:6]. Accepting Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and Savior has afforded me freedom, in God.
