Upcoming Visit – Lune Valley Karting

We are pleased to inform you that we are proposing a fun end of term trip to Lune Valley Karting on Wednesday 14 July 2021. This activity is aimed at improving confidence both on and off the track.

We will be leaving school at 10am and returning at 3pm.

The organisers are able to assure us that karts and equipment are routinely disinfected and a nightly deep clean also takes place.

- Reflexes are improved due to the need to be aware of surroundings and staying alert
- Improved concentration – being behind a wheel requires attention at all times

We will be travelling in the school cars (all of which are equipped with a first aid kit and fire extinguisher). Staff and pupils will be required to wear a face mask in the car and sanitise their hands both upon arrival and on leaving the centre.
