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Who Said That?

The Bible Game of Identifying Speakers & Verses Introduction & Instructions

Our Bible is full of famous statements made by the heroes of our faith. But how good are you at identifying who said what? This game provides another fun, yet powerful, way to learn more and teach more about Christian faith essentials. It's fast, fun, and furiously paced! And people who play repeatedly will learn most of the important quotations in our Bible!

Why is Who Said That? Important?

Have you ever spoken to a teenager and realized he had no idea when World War II was fought? Some college professors today are amazed to find that some students think World War II was fought in the 1980s. Or that the Revolutionary War was fought a hundred years ago. Or that Martin Luther King Jr. was killed within the past 10 years. These students know nothing of the peace walks in Birmingham in the 1960s. They don't know what the Holocaust was, or they mix it up with the Hindenburg, thinking the Holocaust was a giant gas balloon that blew up in the sky!

We feel sorry for our young people. And they make us anxious. We feel that they can't know where we are going as a nation, or how to guide us in the future, unless they understand a little better where we came from in the past.

How Does This Relate To Christianity?

The same is true with us Christians and our knowledge of the Bible! We feel we can know better what God is saying to us if we know what he said to others in history, and when it was said, and to whom. But, alas, most of us are not Bible scholars! We hold more in common with today's young people than we like to confess!

Generally speaking, that's okay. Learning is supposed to be fun. That's why games are designed—and this game will keep folks competing, thinking, laughing, giggling, rejoicing, and learning! Move over Bible Trivial Pursuit and Bible Jeopardy! Make room for Who Said That? as the easiest, most fun way to learn more history of our faith.

You Don't Have To Be a Scholar

The game is designed to appeal to different skill levels. Whether you have been Christian for one year or 30--or you read your Bible daily or haven't picked it up in quite a while—you can play Who Said That? without feeling uneasy about your level of un-

derstanding. New Christians will be amazed at the Bible voices they recognize while playing Level One. Those with a solid base of Bible knowledge will enjoy playing the harder levels and learning even more!

The game is targeted for intermediate players—those who are not Bible scholars but who have taken some sincere interest in what it says. Beginners in our faith will learn the most, and Bible scholars will get to share the most. Playing will benefit any and all parties, regardless of age!

How to Play Who Said That?

You need at least two players and one host. The host will confirm the answers using the Answer Sheets. With crowds, others can join in as teammates. The game comes with three decks of 50 color-coded cards, which you can use for three different rounds, or create new rounds by mixing them up!

Playing with Two Players

Playing Who Said That? is intriguing, addictive, and yet incredibly easy. Lay the stack of cards on the table, face-up, with only the top card facing down. Pick a player to go first. Turn the top card face-up. That player must read the quotation. He will be given two or three options of who said it and sometimes to whom or about whom (Jesus to Satan, Jesus to the Pharisees, Paul to the Corinthians). The player must pick the correct option. If he does, he gets to keep the card. If he is incorrect, the card goes to the bottom of the deck.

The second player sees the second card and guesses which of the parties presented said it. If he is correct, he keeps the card. If he is wrong, the card goes to the bottom of the deck.

Other players take a turn in the same way.

Object of the Game

To win Who Said That? one must be the player to collect the most cards, staffs, scrolls, and crosses, and thereby have the highest score.

Playing with Teams or Crowds

Who Said That? is great for entertainment at potluck dinners or as a fundraiser when church members sponsor a player. The rules are the same, only instead of two players, you can have teams. Teams can "stack" their players, so that the most studious player is answering Levels Three or Four questions, and the less-studied Christian is answering the Level One questions.

Playing at the Higher Levels

The higher levels are just as easy to play and understand.

Level Two Play: In Level Two, players not only get to guess who made the quote, but in which book of the Bible it is found. If a player guesses both, he not only gets to keep the card, but he is awarded a staff card.

Level Three Play: In Level Three, players guess not only who made the quote, but in which book of the Bible and which chapter it is found. If a player guesses all three, he keeps the card, the staff, and also gets a scroll card.

Level Four Play: In Level Four, players not only guess who made the quote, but in which book of the Bible, which chapter, and which verse it is found. This is generally not easy! While John 3:16 is included, so are stories from many books in the Old and New Testaments and all the most famous salvation Scriptures. If they get a verse right, they also get one of the more rare cross cards. Hence, if a player guesses all four parts—who said the quote, plus the book, chapter, and verse, he keeps the card, staff, scroll, and a cross. If the passage on a card contains more than one verse of Scripture, the player gets the cross if he or she names ANY of the verses correctly.

Easy Scorekeeping At All Levels

Regardless of the level of play, each item won can simply be worth one point. For example, at the end of a round, if a player has 20 cards, 10 staffs, 10 scrolls, and five crosses, he has 45 points. If he has 10 cards and four staffs, he has 14 points. Higher levels of play will yield higher scores.

However, as the Level Four verses are so difficult to get, you can opt to increase the value of the cross cards to five points each. It will make scorekeeping slightly more complicated, but also encourages people to really think and remember where Bible stories are found. Just decide on the scoring before the game starts.

How to Use Answer Sheets

There are three Answer Sheets, corresponding with each of the three rounds. At the top of each card is a Game Number and Card Number, which correspond with the number on the appropriate Answer Sheet. Hence, if you have shuffled the cards, the answers will still apply by looking up the number on the Answer Sheet that corresponds with the number on the card.

Each numbered answer on the Answer Sheets provides the answers to *all four levels of play:* who said it, the Bible book, chapter, and verse. Each also includes in parentheses a brief synopsis of the Bible story from which the quote came (i.e. David kills Goliath). Some popular quotations that are not part of a specific story or situation will simply read "Most Famous Scriptures." While there is no point value for naming the information

in the parentheses, it is another great learning tool, as players or audiences will want to know the context.

Important Note about Quotations in More than One Gospel

Many Gospels contain very similar versions of the same story. Due to its narrative richness, we have taken almost all Gospel *stories* from the *Gospel of Matthew*. Nonetheless, all the Gospels contain their own famous quotes, which may not have to do with stories. Any player trying to identify a Gospel quote should not automatically default to Matthew, as all Gospels are well represented in this game.

If a player names the same story in another Gospel: It would be up to the host to decide before the game begins if points should be awarded in that case. If that is desired, be sure to have a Bible or electronic device available for those few lookups.

Easy Set-Up and Easy Use of Materials

All our materials can be generated and parts can be replaced with a black- and-white printer! You will have the downloads enclosed to give you all the essential game pieces as follows:

- 3 Decks of Printable Cards (print out on three different colors of paper)
- 3 Sets of Answer Sheets (print out in colors coordinating with the 3 Decks of Printable Cards)
- 1 Set of Level Two Staff Cards (need to be cut up)
- 1 Set of Level Three Scroll Cards (need to be cut up)
- 1 Set of Level Four Cross Cards (need to be cut up)

Play, Learn, Laugh, Love

The beauty of Who Said That? is its simplicity. It's easy to set up, easy to play, easy to win (at the lower levels), and it makes both learning and teaching extremely easy too! It's also very flexible, usable for big teams in front of large audiences, yet also good as a study tool for one player. Kids just learning to read can join in the fun at Level One, amazing themselves at the stories they recognize; yet Bible scholars can play against

each other at Level Four to raise charity funds or simply for fun. Sunday school teachers, adult cell group leaders, youth ministers, and Christians who love to host parties will find Who Said That? a great addition to their entertainment agendas.

Several minutes of printing and two minutes of cutting puts a great game in your hands. You will use it for years, bringing many to a greater level of understanding of what was said in Bible times... and what God might be saying now!


