Enjoy a picturesque day on the North Shore and don't forget your camera. We will travel to a world recognized fishing port and visit the Gloucester Fisherman Statue, a memorial to the thousands who have lost their lives at sea. It was here that the Gloucester resident and fisherman Clarence Birdseye invented quick-freezing food in 1925 changing the eating habits of our entire nation.

Board the Thomas P. Lannon Schooner at the Seven Seas Warf for a 1.5 hour private harbor cruise. You are welcome to join the crew and even take the helm; or just sit back and relax, taking in all the sights. You will learn about the harbor and hear many true stories past and present about the Gloucester area and its fishermen. (There is a nautical head on the boat.)

Afterwards, enjoy exploring the shops and historic waterfront district with many choices for lunch (on own). Before returning home, we will visit the Fisherman's Memorial - It is an eight-foot tall, bronze statue of a fisherman dressed in oilskins standing braced at the wheel on the sloping deck of his ship. It is positioned so that the fisherman is looking out over Gloucester Harbor which pays tribute to those lost at sea.
