Step 3 Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID 19 Pandemic

As of 17 May 2021 we are at Step 3 of the Government's COVID-19 Response Roadmap. It is important to reduce the risk of virus transmission, therefore various factors such as the R number, new variants of the virus and local hospital admissions should be taken into account. Although the vaccine rollout programme is very successful, it is recommended that the key measures, which churches and parishes have been carrying out, remain in place for now:

Hand sanitiser must continue to be used on entry to churches & before liturgies as in current church guidance, reduces risk. Please either scan in on the NHS Track & Trace or tick your name off the register.
The wearing of face coverings, even if removed by law, remains at least for now (apart from those who are exempt.). Please ensure that face coverings are worn properly, covering the nose, to reduce aerosol or droplet spread.

3) <u>Social Distancing continues.</u> People sit 1m apart in the church pews.

Reassessment of covid-secure capacity of the church Churches can safely increase the covid-secure capacity of the building based on the principles of combination prevention, specifically: proper seating arrangements, face coverings, ventilation, hand sanitising and vaccines listed. In some churches, this reassessment may bring the covid-secure capacity up to 50% of the building.

Indoor congregational singing is still prohibited, but single small group of singers will be allowed to perform only where essential to an act of communal worship.

<u>Offertory collection at Mass</u> There are baskets at the entrance and exit from the church. Where possible, please use the contactless donation system. Payments can be made from a Stand in the church porch.

Physical exchange of a Sign of Peace remains suspended.

Holy Communion is given in the hand only. Please wait in your pew until instructed to move forward. The communicant should have his/her arms outstretched to the full, palms facing upwards, one on top of the other. After unlooping the face covering the communicant consumes the Sacred Host at the sanctuary steps, replaces the face covering and moves back to the pew via one of the side aisles.
