Father Ruben (also from Poland) wanted a painting of a co-founder of the Redemptorists for the 200th anniversary of his death. The Vatican has free showers available for the poor, Sister Anna helps people at the public showers and often spotted Adam sketching while waiting for his turn at the showers. Fr Ruben told sister Anna of his problem, was Introduced to Adam (who had a passion for art but never studied it). Fr Ruben provided Adam with paints and brushes, and provided a workspace in a church crypt.

Don't Use Cash?

Since the start of the pandemic I have hardly ever used cash, and lots of sales points ask us to avoid cash.

We've been reluctant to have a "Donate" button on our website - many parishes and dioceses do - but we'd like to provide a service.

So now in the church there's a cash-free way of contributing, and the method is simple. It's well explained at the machine.

If you choose to contribute this way, your donation is split between the two church collections, the Common Fund Collection for the clergy of the parish and diocese, and the Share Collection. Giving directly avoids any charges for using the system.

I tested the system on Wednesday. It accepted my money but it hasn't yet (10.30 Thursday) shown up as a payment from my credit card.

Thanks for supporting the parish and the diocese by whatever method you choose.
