The PATIENCE of the Lord!

Many people do NOT like CHANGE. It causes anxiety. Many other people see CHANGE as a new beginning bringing new opportunities. Some changes are due to circumstances and unavoidable, others are chosen. Even when chosen, change can be difficult. In today's *first reading* we find the Prophet Isaiah giving hope to people who are in despair and, doubting God's promise, thinking that he has abandoned them in their exile in Babylon. Isaiah encourages the people to continue to trust in God who will lead them from slavery back to the Promised Land. In the *second reading* from the letter of Peter the purpose of God's plan is seen as giving people time to CHANGE. *The Gospel* offers the HOPE of a new beginning. To trust in God's providence requires great faith as even the disciples who knew Jesus in the flesh struggled to believe in him. Therefore, if we have doubts we should not lose heart as the path to becoming a friend of God needs time. Each person is unique and we may all be at different places on our Faith 'Journey'. We need to always remember that God works in his own time and way. We might make the following our prayer–"*Lord, I believe, help my unbelief*".

<u>ST. JOHN'S SEMINARY, WONERSH</u> This past week we have heard the news that St John's Seminary in Wonersh is to close in its present form. The Seminary has served the Church for 130 years and there is great sadness that formation must now end at the site.

Unfortunately there was no new intake this September. With the seminarian body numbering just 17 the community is small, with the building and staffing costs too high to sustain. Arrangements have been made for the remaining seminarians to join the community at Allen Hall, Chelsea in Sept 2021.

Archbishop John Wilson and Bishop Richard are committed to providing priestly formation that will serve the people of our Dioceses and parishes into the future. St John's will remain a legal entity so that consideration can be given to the ways in which the tradition of priestly formation established at Wonersh in 1891 will continue.

The Trustees of St John's are extremely grateful to rectors, staff and seminarians, past and present, and to all those who have supported the Seminary over the years. We ask our Diocesan church family to pray for vocations to the priesthood, keeping our seminarians in their thoughts and prayers over the coming months.
