"THY KINGDOM COME"

The SEVEN Kingdoms of the earth

A pagan Babylonian king was given a dream from God, but when he awoke, he could not remember the dream.

None could tell the king the dream. But God, who is "...a revealer of secrets" (DANIEL 2:47), revealed the dream to Daniel, his servant.

The dream revealed six future kingdoms that would arise upon this earth after Babylon.

Daniel told King Nebuchadnezzar "...what shall be in the latter days...Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image...This image's head was of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of brass, His legs of iron, his feet

part of iron and part of clay. Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet that were of iron and clay, and brake them to pieces." (DANIEL 2).

The nation **Babylon** was the head of gold, and the beginning of the rule of the Gentiles (ANYONE WHO IS NOT A JEW). "And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee" (vs. 39). This was **Medo-Persia** (Iran), "and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth." This was **Greece**. "And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron" (vs. 40). This was the **Rome Empire**. "And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the [FIFTH] kingdom

shall be divided" (vs. 41-49).

We are now living during this "DIVIDED KINGDOM" age, and because democracy invites division, it will be abolished when the King of Fierce Countenance takes power, and brings unity and peace to the world for three and a half years.

Then he will break his covenant with **Israel**, and bloodshed will begin.

without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold;


