Susan volunteers with us each month at the Community Humane Shelter of Steuben County. We cannot thank her enough for all of her help each month.

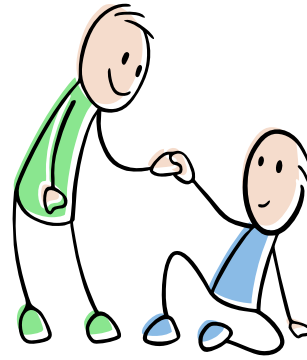
