## **CASTING ASIDE 'OLD BAGGAGE'!**

Jesus sent out the Twelve in pairs with clear instructions about how to carry out their 'Mission'. His Apostles had been chosen for that task at that particular time. Most people have responsibilities which they can't just drop. However, we can all take something from the message in today's Gospel. We may carry around certain personal 'baggage' that can hold us back, and make us less fruitful: perhaps an old grudge, a certain envy or resentment of someone else. We may find something difficult to forgive, or be held back by an unworthy attachment to something. All these can both frustrate our own development and prevent us from contributing all that we could. Part of the Gospel message of repentance is trying to put aside this negative baggage, to travel more lightly and be freer to serve. Christ has given us a means to get rid of this sort of baggage. Through the sacraments we can both leave behind what hinders us and move forward in the service of Christ. As the Apostles had great faith and courage to do what Christ told them, we too can ask for that faith and courage and be effective 'Evangelisers' in our time.

<u>Latest Guidance for Communal Worship</u> The final easing of lockdown restrictions is still set for 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Until then, we must comply with the Covid secure measures of HANDS – FACE – SPACE.

Doors and windows should be opened to provide ventilation.

The church should be cleaned after services with frequent touchpoints requiring more regular cleaning.

Hand sanitising should be available to those entering or leaving the church.

<u>Individuals or bubbles/households</u> should be seated at a social distance of 2m (or 1m with face coverings) from other groups or individuals. <u>Holy Communion</u> is distributed under one kind only.

Offertory baskets continue to be positioned where people can make their offering when arriving or leaving church.
