From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

Pope Francis has instituted this year as the Year of Grace dedicated to St. Joseph. It is a call to learn more about this man who is silent in the Gospel but had a profound impact in the life of Jesus and Mary and the whole Church. This year is an opportunity to know more about him in depth. During the year, I will be publishing things about St. Joseph. I leave you here with this sermon of St. Bernardine of Siena on St. Joseph to help us reflect on this very fundamental figure.

"This is the general rule that applies to all individual graces given to a rational creature. Whenever divine grace selects someone to receive a particular grace, or some especially favored position, all the gifts for his state are given to that person, and enrich him abundantly. This is especially true of that holy man Joseph, the supposed father of our Lord Jesus Christ, and true husband of the queen of the world and of the angels. He was chosen by the eternal Father to be the faithful foster-parent and guardian of the most precious treasures of God, his Son and his spouse. This was the task which he so faithfully carried out. For this, the Lord said to him, 'Good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of your Lord.'" God will never give us more than what we can handle, and He will always give us the graces that are necessary for the mission He will entrust us. As we learn this, we are invited to imitate Joseph in trusting God when He is calling him to a mission that seems beyond his strength. Never be afraid to say YES to the Lord."

My dear parishioners, I invite you to support the mission of our Church and for this we depend on the generosity of the disciples. I hope we all participate, even the widow in the Gospel had something to contribute. Our goal is \$ 19,811. We have reached 22% of our goal, let us continue working together and let us pray for each other every day.


Saint Vincent de Paul Poor Fund

What the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches about marriage:

1660 The marriage covenant, by which a man and a woman form with each other an intimate communion of life and love, has been founded and endowed with its own special laws by the Creator. By its very nature it is ordered to the good of the couple, as well as to the generation and education of children. Christ the Lord raised marriage between the baptized to the dignity of a sacrament (cf. CIC, can. 1055 § 1; cf. GS 48 § 1).
1661 The sacrament of Matrimony signifies the union of Christ and the Church. It gives spouses the grace to love each other with the love with which Christ has loved his Church; the grace of the sacrament thus perfects the human love of the spouses, strengthens their indissoluble unity, and sanctifies them on the way to eternal life (cf.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos enseña sobre el sacramento del matrimonio:

1660 La alianza matrimonial, por la que un hombre y una mujer constituyen una íntima comunidad de vida y de amor, fue fundada y dotada de sus leyes propias por el Creador. Por su naturaleza está ordenada al bien de los cónyuges así como a la generación y educación de los hijos. Entre bautizados, el matrimonio ha sido elevado por Cristo Señor a la dignidad de sacramento (cf. GS 48,1; CIC can. 1055, §1).

1661 El sacramento del Matrimonio significa la unión de Cristo con la Iglesia. Da a los esposos la gracia de amarse con el amor con que Cristo amó a su Iglesia; la gracia del sacramento perfecciona así el amor humano de los esposos, reafirma su unidad indisoluble y los santifica en el camino de la vida eterna (cf. Concilio de Trento: DS 1799).
