July 5, 2018 Meeting

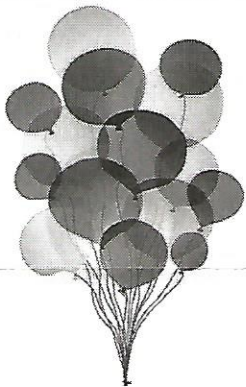
Penfield, Illinois
