**Melissa Rodriguez** has been a prosecutor with the San Bernardino County District Attorney's Office since 2007. She is a Supervising Deputy District Attorney and currently supervises the juvenile division, officer involved shooting division and human trafficking unit. She has worked in multiple units, including the family violence unit and the major crimes unit. She was appointed to create and lead the first vertical countywide Human Trafficking Unit and successfully prosecuted the first case in the state where a trafficker received life in prison. She also regularly trains law enforcement in multiple areas and is a subject matter expert in human trafficking.
