Temporary suspension of Mass with congregation in attendance

Following the recent News that cases of COVID-19 are increasing at an alarming rate, on a daily basis, in our area – up from just 57 cases per 100,000 of the population in mid-December to approx. 700 per 100,000 - We have taken the necessary steps to protect all members of our community. We are hearing of the difficulties which Hospital and ambulance Services are experiencing and the need to protect the NHS & Medical Staff.

On the advice of many parishioners, some of whom have continued to attend Mass in our Churches, we have decided that both St. Patrick's and Our Lady of Lourdes Church will be CLOSED for regular PUBLIC MASSES, until further notice.
