

NORTHEAST MICHIGAN ASSESSOR'S ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP POLICY:

The Northeast Michigan Assessor's Association supports education in the field of assessment administration.

Course Requirements:

The assessing course must be approved by the State Tax Commission for assessing certification credit or assessing certification renewal credit.

The class must be offered by the Michigan Assessor's Association (MAA), International Association of Assessing Officers, State Tax Commission, Northeast Michigan Assessor's Association, or any affiliate of the MAA.

The course must be located in the State of Michigan.

Applicant Requirements:

The applicant must be a current member of the Northeast Michigan Assessor's Association and the Michigan Assessor's Association.

The applicant must work in a government assessing or equalization department office that will not fund all or part of the course fees. Written evidence from the employer must be submitted with the scholarship application.

The Scholarship:

The scholarship will cover the cost of the course, lab fee, and required text up to an amount of \$200 (excluding lab fee for a golf course class).

The scholarship is in the form of a reimbursement. Reimbursement will be given after a copy of notice of a passing grade or for non-tested classes a copy of the certificate of attendance.

The scholarship is limited to one course per student per year.

Scholarships will be made based on available funding after review by the Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be notified by email or in writing.
