BRAHA High Point Program

Program Rules

The BRAHA High Point Program is open to all BRAHA members. The goal of this program is to promote greater competitive participation and patronage, and honor the Purebred and Partbred Arabians as well as non-Arabian horses owned by BRAHA members for their outstanding achievements.

To be eligible for this program ALL horses must be entered in at least one class to be eligible and they must be entered by a BRAHA member in good standing. You must enter and pay for each division that you would like to participate in. A copy of registration papers for horses must be included, except for horses that entered in the Non-Arabian Division.

Nominations are due to High Point Chairman by September 1st with an entry fee of \$25.00, late entries may be sent in for a late fee of \$50.00 per division by September 30th.

Show/Event Verification - A Secretary's signature is not required, but the following information MUST be provided on the tally point sheet and sent to the High Point Chairman by the required date: Show Name/Event, Date, Rating, Class, Placing, Secretary's name and phone number/ and or e-mail. Please do not send sheets without this information. No points will be given for events that are missing information from your tally sheet.

Tally Point Sheet Deadline- Tally point sheets must be post marked by September 15th, but we would prefer they be sent on a monthly basis. Tally sheets may be sent by postal mail or e-mail please include your e-mail address on postal delivery so deliver conformation may be sent. Points accumulated after the due date may still be eligible, however you must notify the High point Chairman of your intentions. Points one week prior to the banquet may NOT count, this will be decided upon by the High Point Chairman based on the awards given (personalized awards need time to be completed). Those points however may be applied to the following year.

Award Presentation- All Awards will be presented at the BRAHA banquet which is held the first Saturday in November at Timbuktu (1726 Dorsey Road Hanover, Maryland). If you are unable to attend, please contact someone to pick up your awards or make arrangement with the High Point Chairman to get your awards. Expenses will be the responsibility of the award recipient.

Bonus Points- A 100 point bonus will be awarded per horse entered in any BRAHA sponsored event. Exhibitors must choose the category to which the points would be applied, or may spread the points across divisions. Points may be applied only to categories in which that horse has been entered at that given event.

Over All High Point Award- Additional awards will be presented to the highest scoring Arabian/PB Halter horse Arabian/PB performance horse, Youth in hand and Youth performance, and Highest scoring In Hand Open horse and Open Performance horse.
