

# PRINCE2 STUDY GUIDE Pdf Free



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There are no trick questions — allegedly. It has eight sections, each with ten questions. Questions are different styles of multiple choice, such as matching questions and sequence questions. As with the Foundation exam, there are no levels of pass. The result is simply a pass or a fail. Your

training company may give you your result very quickly, or it will follow within about two weeks — after the paper has been marked centrally. Roles and responsibilities: Make sure you know what each role is responsible for within the project management team and what the roles are doing in a PRINCE2 project. Processes: Check you know the sequence in which the processes are used, who is primarily responsible for the activities within each process, and who else is involved.

Themes: Go through them all again to be sure you have a clear understanding. Management products: Make sure you know what each product is used for and when, who produces it and what the sections in each one are all about. Product planning for Practitioner level : Make sure you understand the diagrams and the Product Description, and practise drawing some diagrams. As the questions are compiled from a limited question bank, the more practice questions you attempt, the more prepared you will be.

Practising the sample papers also helps you to refine your technique, and you will be able to predict how well you are likely to perform in the actual exam. PRINCE2 Foundation exam tip - if you find it difficult to remember things, try colour-coding or highlighting your revision notes. Visual revision tools, such as mind maps, flow charts and organisational models, are also an invaluable form of preparation.

Memorizing and reproducing these for yourself will further aid your understanding of PRINCE2, and ultimately improve your chances of exam success. There are three things to keep in mind during the Foundation exam— timing, question complexity and making sure to answer every question. Timing is the most important aspect to keep in mind. The exam consists of 75 questions, and there are 60 minutes to answer them. This only allows 48 seconds per question. The strategy we recommend is the three pass approach. Pass 1 — go through the entire question paper from start to finish and answer those questions which you feel confident about and only take a few seconds to answer. Mark your answer on the answer sheet and mark your question paper so show you have answered the question. Leave any questions you are unsure about. Pass 2 — go through the unanswered questions, this time spending seconds reading each one.

Mark the answer sheet with your answers and your question paper to show you have answered the question. At the end of this pass you will only be left with those questions which take a long time to answer, or you are still not sure about. Pass 3 — re-read the remaining questions. By a process of elimination, discount those options which you think are definitely wrong.

Cross them out on the question booklet. If you do this, you can often eliminate 2 options straightaway which will leave you with 2 options left to choose from. Read the question and the 2 remaining options one more time and if you really cannot decide guess. Whatever you do, make sure that one option has been selected on your answer sheet for all 75 questions in the question booklet. Preparing well, knowing what to expect and thoroughly understanding the PRINCE2 methodology, will all greatly improve your chances of success. Also, statistics show that high-scorers in the Foundation exam will have a better chance at getting a high score in Practitioner, which is certainly something to keep in mind. Thorough knowledge of how PRINCE2 works and a great exam technique will lead to exam success, and you should feel reassured that all the questions are multiple-choice.
