God's People Confess Their Faith: (WCF26:1)

All saints that are united to Jesus Christ their Head, by His Spirit, and by faith, have fellowship with Him in His grace, sufferings, death, resurrection, and glory: and, being united to one another in love, they have communion in each other's gifts and graces, and are obliged to the performance of such duties, public and private, as do promote their mutual good, both in the inward and outward man.

God Calls Us to Repentance:

And the Pharisees and their scribes grumbled at his disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" And Jesus answered them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance." Luke 5:30–32

God's People Confess Their Sin

Our Father in Heaven, we have no right to call You *Father* because we have sinned against You; we ought to come before You as guilty, condemned sinners to a judge about to pass – and execute – sentence. But we come through Christ our only Mediator to You our Father confessing our sin with shame and sorrow, for we have not kept Your commandments. We have not kept pure all the religious worship You have commanded in Your word; we have not been zealous for Your worship as You are zealous for it. We have neglected to live in light of Your sovereignty as the great King above all gods. Instead of allowing Your word to dwell richly in us, we have allowed created things – traditions, symbols, and superstitions – to have spiritual power over us and value for us. Forgive us for how passionate we can be about our own traditions and how disinterested we are to seek You as You command us in Your word. Show us mercy in Christ, take away our shame and cover us with Your love anew that we may delight to worship You in Spirit and Truth in accordance with Your holy and word revealed will.
