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INTRODUCTION

BIBLE HERO FACT FILES

Welcome to Bible Hero Fact Files, a fun way to learn about Bible characters with several ways to play! Students can win or lose Bible Knowledge Badges, have relays, or just sit in groups and discuss situations, like what they would have done if they were in a certain Bible character's shoes.

The sure thing is that your students will have a grand overview of 24 of the Bible's Old and New Testament heroes after filling out the pages. They will know when each lived and what they did to become one of the most notable people in Bible history—plus a couple of interesting facts that often escape people's notice.

Let's look at the package and all the ways to use it.

Eight Bible Lookup Questions are on each sheet, which will provide your students with the most important information about each hero. We provide some fun ways to engage students in these lookups—including our two games: ***Get Those Bible Badges and Fact File Relays.***

A Timeline clearly marked with when each character lived will help students understand their place in Bible events.

A UNSCRAMBLE Puzzle is included on each page that may or may not require a Bible lookup. Because kids love puzzles, this will be sure to intrigue while teaching them a famous Bible saying by or about that hero.

A Boxed Activity provides a variety of exercises in thinking, memorizing, or illustrating—while having fun!

Teacher's Answer Sheets are provided for all 22 Fact Files. They cover not only answers to the Bible lookup questions, but also to the unscramble phrases.

How to Use the Fact File Sheets

We're suggesting two games your students can play with the sheets, though the sheets can also be used as a straight learning tool. The games just add fun and intrigue.

Use the New International Version of the Bible

Whether playing games or just using the sheets for learning, it is important to use the New International Version (NIV) of the Bible with the sheets. Some of the answers are exacting, and another version might confuse players.

Why this Package is Important

We don't want children to just know the names of the Bible books or be able to recite a dozen important verses. By the time they are eight years old, or halfway through their Sunday school years, they should be starting to get an overview picture of the story God is telling in his one amazing Bible.

When they're just starting out, kids can automatically think surprising things that will thwart their understanding of God's divine story. They can think David lived during the time of Jesus. They can think Abraham is not important because he didn't perform miracles. They can think women were not important back then.

Here's an example of what a student will understand, having gone through all our *Fact File sheets*: "David lived 1,000 years before Jesus. He's probably most famous for killing Goliath, but he was also King of Israel for 30 years. He wrote lots of Psalms, played the lyre, and his son Solomon built the Temple."

Bible heroes will change, in your students' minds, from isolated men and women who did things that are hard to remember. They will become like a team working for God where each one's individual work fits in as a chapter of the same story!

Here are two games you can play with the Bible Hero Sheets that will prevent Bible Lookups from being drudgery in their minds. Watch thinking caps go on and students try to win with animation!

GAME #1: GET THOSE BIBLE BADGES (A TABLE GAME)

BIBLE HERO FACT FILES

The *Fact File* sheets work like a table game with students risking their badges based on how sure they are of their guesses. The game works well with single players, but can be even more fun in pairs. If using single players, simply substitute “players” for “pairs” in the description below.

Materials Needed

- Fact File Sheets (included)
- 1 Copy of the Bible in NIV
- Bible Badges (included)
- Pencils
- Timer, such as the one on a smartphone
- Basket or container, such as a collection basket

Preparation

1. Print 1 copy of the same Fact File sheet for each pair.
2. Print and cut out enough badges so that is 30 badges per pair.
3. Establish the pairs of students. (Establish fair pairs. Two eleven-year-olds against two seven-year-olds is not exactly fair!)
4. Give each pair 1 Fact File Sheet, pencils, and 15 badges.
5. Put all remaining badges into the “kitty,” the container in the middle of the table.

Rules

1. When you say, “GO,” pairs have five minutes to go off into corners to complete the sheet by guessing the answers. They should skip the boxed activity, which is not used until after the rounds. (Allowing students to guess before doing Bible lookups is a great idea, because in the brain function of children, a correct guess is a learned answer!)
2. At the end of five minutes, say “STOP,” and all pairs must return to the learning table with their answer sheet covered (it’s like a hand of cards—don’t tilt!). Take away pencils.
3. Ask for a volunteer pair to do the first Bible lookup. After that, the student to the left of the last student to complete a lookup will look up the next answer.
4. Before doing a Bible lookup, pairs should decide how many badges they are willing to risk based on how sure they are of their answer. It is up to a pair to decide whether they want to risk zero, one, two, or three badges. For example:
 - a. If a pair feels completely unsure, they need not risk any badges. However, those who do not put in any badges may not take any away if they have the correct answer.
 - b. If a pair feels more sure of their answer, they can risk up to three badges—no more.
5. All pairs put their risked badges in front of them, and then the student whose turn it is does t

he Bible lookup.

6. Pairs who guessed an answer correctly: They get their badges back plus the same number that they risked from the kitty.
7. Pairs who guessed incorrectly: They lose their badges to the kitty.
8. Move on to the next of the eight lookups until all are completed. Students should count their badges and announce which pair is in first place.
9. The simple game ends here. But for added fun, use the Unscramble Round; involving the unscramble phase on each Fact File sheet.

Unscramble Round

10. Pairs qualify for the UNSCRAMBLE round if they attempted to unscramble the phrase on their sheets during their five initial minutes to guess answers.
11. Pairs who get the phrase correct can take 5 Bible badges from any pair of their choosing. They may only take from 1 pair. (However, this can drastically change the score if three pair take 5 badges each from the team that won the simple round.

Breaking Ties

Ties do not have to be broken, especially if you are playing rounds. You will simply carry the tied score into the next round, which will start with a new Fact File sheet and each pair having 15 Bible Badges.

12. To break ties if desired, have all pairs complete the BOXED ACTIVITY. Students vote on who did the best job, and the votes may include anything from handwriting to creative originality to illustrating skills. Here's the clincher: Pairs may not vote for their own BOXED ACTIVITY! They must vote for another pair.
13. The pair with the most votes on the BOXED ACTIVITY will be the winners in the case of a tie in one round or as many rounds make up your game.

GAME #2: FACT FILE
RELAY GAME

BIBLE HERO FACT FILES

Materials

- 2 copies of the same Fact File Sheet
- 2 Bibles in NIV Translation
- 2 pencils

Preparation

1. Create a free play area that goes from wall to wall and around 6 feet wide.
2. Lay two copies of the same Fact File sheets on the floor at one end of the room with lots of space in between them (so that teams cannot see each other's answer sheets and copy from them).
3. Place a Bible on top of each sheet along with a pencil.
4. Bring all students down to the other end of the room and form two teams.
5. Explain the rules, especially the scoring and the deductions, which creates all the fun and intrigue.

Rules & Instructions

1. When you say "Go!" the first student on each team races to their own sheet, pencil, and Bible.
2. Once there, a student may peruse the entire sheet for an answer of which he or she is fairly certain. Players do not have to do the Bible lookup and may simply fill in an answer to save time.
3. After laying down the pencil and Bible, that student should run back to his or her team, and the next student proceeds to the sheet.
4. The game ends when the first team has all its answers filled in.
5. At that point, the other team must stop and leave remaining answers blank.

To score, use the teacher's answer sheet and follow these rules:

1. An answer that is left blank by the team that did not finish first is worth -5 points.
2. An incorrect answer is worth -10 points.
3. Every correct answer is worth +10 points.

Go over the scoring carefully so that they all understand the choice each needs to make: *They will be tempted to not complete Bible Lookups because they take time, and time can mean more blank answers at the end of the round. They must use discretion. Because a wrong answer is worth **TWICE THE DEDUCTION** of an incomplete answer.*

Suggestions:

1. If students can't resist the urge to guess and do extremely poorly, have them complete the same Fact File sheet again--after hearing the answers from the Teachers' Answer Sheet. If some team members remember the answers once this repeat round begins, they have the option to shout to their teammate whose turn it is. However, the other team will likely hear. (Pig Latin has been a workable solution for some).
2. While scoring the first round, announce to students that they will be completing the same sheet in the next round so to listen carefully to answers.

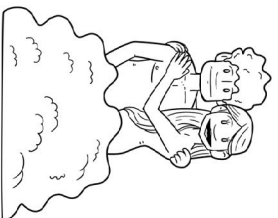
The game ends when the teams have completed as many Fact File sheets as you wish, and the team with the most points wins.
