

BCYFA Tiebreaker System

1. If two teams are tied:

A. Head to head

If teams did not play each other:

A. Record against common opponents

B. Number of wins by defeated opponents

C. Coin toss

2. If more than two teams are tied:

A. Head to head (one team beat all of the other teams involved in the tie) - once a tie is broken the winner of the tiebreaker is placed and the process starts over again.

B. Record against common opponents

C. Number of wins by defeated opponents

D. Coin toss

NOTE - Points (game scores) will not be used in any way in breaking ties so as not to encourage running up scores and so forth. A 1 point win counts the same as a 50 point win!!!
