## **BCYFA Tiebreaker System**

1. If two teams are tied:

A. Head to head

If teams did not play each other:

- A. Record against common opponents
- B. Number of wins by defeated opponents
- C. Coin toss

2. If more than two teams are tied:

A. Head to head (one team beat all of the other teams involved in the tie) - once a tie is broken the winner of the tiebreaker is placed and the process starts over again.

- B. Record against common opponents
- C. Number of wins by defeated opponents
- D. Coin toss

NOTE - Points (game scores) will not be used in any way in breaking ties so as not to encourage running up scores and so forth. A 1 point win counts the same as a 50 point win!!!
