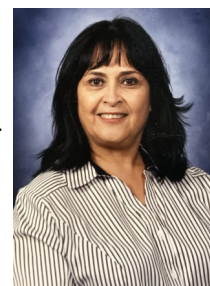

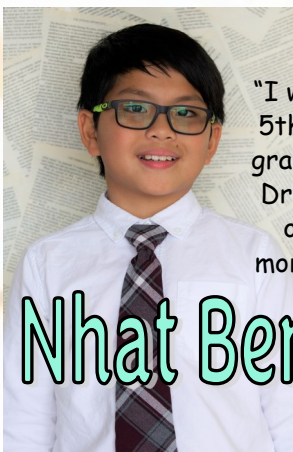
"I will miss my class because of how chaotic they are and I will miss my friends. I am a bit happy to go to middle school and get out of elementary school."

"I will miss all of the students, teachers, and staff after I leave SHCS. I will miss all of my friends that I will not see in middle school. I will always remember my time here at SHCS."



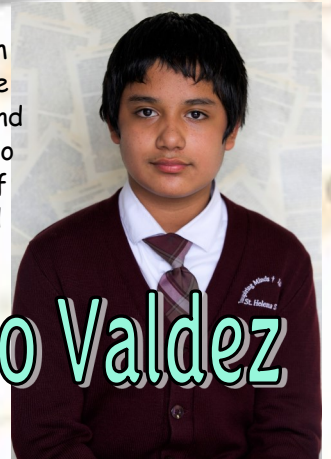
