EXECUTIVE ORDER 0009

INACTIVE CITIZENSHIP REVOCATION PROCEDURE

By virtue of the authority vested in me, by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Dracul of 2017, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Dracul was founded and continues to run as an active community, meaning that citizens and government work together to improve the country. When half of the community does not contribute, active status cannot be maintained. Citizens who engage in inactive behavior, such as failing to vote in national or state elections, failing to participate in census or opinion polls, or refusing to set aside time to mingle with their fellow citizens, risk having their citizenship revoked.

There are many organizations, clubs, job positions, communication methods, and ways to interact with the community, including attending in person events for those who reside within travelling distance to Dracul. The maximum amount of inactive time a citizen is allowed to reach is six months. Citizens who have a valid reason for being inactive may be excused.

This policy is also to prevent and cancel out any current “citizenship collectors”, which is defined as an individual who receives citizenship, but has no intention of interacting with the community on any level, other than to initially receive citizenship status.
