MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 12, 2023, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 8th, 2022 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of December was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council set a new travel expense rate, acknowledged receipt of the Fidelity Bond, authorized workers compensation coverage, and completed readings of one bylaw. Council opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program for 2023. Requests for proposals for the supply of diesel fuel and for 2023 gravel hauling and spreading were called. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the RM to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2024 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2023 in several organizations were approved. Advertising in local school yearbooks was approved.

The Board of Revision, the Board of Revision Secretary, the Development Appeals Board, and the Development Appeals Board Secretary were appointed for 2023, and wages and salaries were set. Three revised policies were adopted and a lease agreement was signed. Plant Health Officers and Pest Control Officers were appointed for the purpose of the 2023 clubroot survey.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

One delegation was received to discuss road construction.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:00 p.m.
