Deaths of the Bravos by John Meyers is one of my favorites. It gives the history of our country and the Bravos who died building it. It is about the settling of the West from earliest times up to after the Civil War. It details the trappers and all the names we are familiar with, the long hunters, the city builders, the out-laws, the gold and silver miners, the station builders, and the heroes, and is a page

One of the most interesting thing about it was the portrayal of James Beckworth. July 4, 2015 At Arkansaw

Deer Bruther,

Am writing you a letter to tell you about the battle we was in today. I swear I kan not belive the filthy red coats have still not give up yet. Today a few of us boys was out huntin and even tho we had whooped them soundly in the past to win our indepence from their unfair taxatin an all that, they cum at us agin today. Marchin in them red coats, but them coats made them fair targets. They just marched out there in a row, but weuns we just hid in the trees an picked off their offisers one by one.

They sent them filthy injuns into the woods to hunt us but we's too smart even fur them savages. There was even a Scots guy out there wearing his skirt, can you believe it? Yea, some of the nebors hurd the shootin and cum to hep us out an in the end we whooped' em agin.

A hole lot of folks cum out to watch the battle an seemed to think it was som kind of show, but fer now, we got the filthy red coats on the run, but you never no when they will attack agin.

Huntin is not so good round Little Rock now, too many folks moved in and driv the deer and bar away, but weuns is goin on a big hunt up in the mountins close to Leslie in October, I hopes you can make it, we alwas has a good time. Them folks up there sure are hospitabl an nice an they cums out and joins us round the camp far. I magine ole glen Cook will be thar to tell us sum of his great lies. He can alwas make us laff. So far nuna them pesky red coats have ben up that way.

Wes also got some hunts planned for September that is alwas fun, I sent ya a list of um with his letter, so look it over and plan to make as many of them as ya can and get yer larder stocked up fer the winter.

After Action Report (From a British Standpoint) Saturday July 4th 2015

Unsporting, they started picking off my NCOs and then finally I was hit. I gave the word to the 16th Foote to retreat from the field. The rebel commander ordered his men to advance and drive the Redcoats to the sea. From a distance my men and I could hear the Rebels cheering for their victory. Later one I reflected that you cannot conquer an idea with an Army.

We had over 20 Reenactors for the event and had over 500 visitors watch the public battle. Thank you

to all who came out. Our next colonial event in Arkansas will be January 31st at Cadron Blockhouse in Conway, AR.
