

From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

We find in today's Gospel a very strong word that we are not accustomed to hear from the mouth of Jesus: "hate". A lot of people are following Jesus for a variety of reasons, then he turns and says, "Whoever does not hate" and starts a list that includes family, plans and self and finishes stating that the consequence of not doing that is that they cannot be his disciples. We can say that is a pretty harsh word from Jesus, but it is a very important one I would say. Many times, we forget that above everything is God. We live in a society in which work, studies, family and other things have taken precedence over God. One simple example, God gave us Sunday to rest by worshiping Him and enjoying family (it is the day that God has given us to show us that HE is God and that HE takes care of us). Overtime, Sunday has lost that great meaning; how many families still do Sunday dinner together as a wonderful event? How many of your relatives are still going to mass? How many people you know work on Sunday? But why is Jesus so harsh using "hate". Because, we can break. Let me explain, one thing is our project/plan another is reality. If we spend all our energies trying to make our plan/project work and never have time to sit down with the Lord and to look at our reality and see what He is calling us to, we risk breaking – physically, mentally, emotionally, etc. Today is an invitation to stop and ask why we are following Jesus, and to sit with Him to see what the best for us is according to God.



This week we have several meetings for CCD as we are preparing to start this new journey with our children by forming them in the faith. I ask parents to please attend the meeting you are required so that you can get all the pertinent information for this year. RCIA is about to start to please register if you need your sacraments and are over 18 years old. Youth Group we will have our first Core Team meeting for this year on Friday. Our Pastoral Council will gather on Saturday to start planning this year. Our Finance Council will gather in a week to continue overseeing our parish finances. And in the midst of all this, our parking lot will be repaved this week. Pray for all these projects and may God bless you.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Encontramos en el Evangelio de hoy una palabra muy fuerte que no estamos acostumbrados a escuchar de la boca de Jesús: "odia". Mucha gente está siguiendo a Jesús por una variedad de razones, luego se da vuelta y dice: "Quien no odia" y comienza una lista que incluye la familia, los planes y el yo y termina diciendo que la consecuencia de no hacerlo es que no pueden ser sus discípulos. Podemos decir que es una palabra muy dura de parte de Jesús, pero diría que es muy importante. Muchas veces, olvidamos que por encima de todo está Dios. Vivimos en una sociedad en la que el trabajo, los estudios, la familia y otras cosas tienen prioridad sobre Dios. Un ejemplo simple, Dios nos dio el domingo para descansar adorándolo y disfrutando de la familia (es el día que Dios nos ha dado para mostrarnos que Él es Dios y que Él cuida de nosotros). En horas extras, el domingo ha perdido ese gran significado; ¿Cuántas familias siguen cenando juntos el domingo como un evento maravilloso? ¿Cuántos de tus familiares siguen yendo a misa? ¿Cuántas personas que conoces trabajan el domingo? Pero ¿por qué Jesús es tan duro con el "odia"? Porque nos podemos romper. Permitanme explicar, una cosa es nuestro proyecto / plan, otra es la realidad. Si gastamos todas nuestras energías tratando de hacer que nuestro plan / proyecto funcione y nunca tengamos tiempo para sentarnos con el Señor y mirar nuestra realidad y ver a qué está llamando, corremos el riesgo de rompernos, física, mental, emocional, etc. Hoy es una invitación a parar y preguntar por qué estamos siguiendo a Jesús, y sentarnos con Él para ver qué es lo mejor para nosotros según Dios.

Esta semana tenemos varias reuniones para CCD mientras nos preparamos para comenzar este nuevo viaje con nuestros hijos formándolos en la fe.
