

Editor's Note



If the gradual recovery continues, next summer may be the first in two years that the world's music programs are back on their feet. Assuming so, optimists can look forward to long stretches of time creating and listening to music in the mountains, on the beaches, in historic mansions, stadiums, and rolling green lawns.

As proven by the roughly 300 individual listings here, the phrase summer "camp" no longer strictly applies to children at play, nor does "institute" imply young artists at

work. Collectively, "age and level" entries range from two years old ("Country Dance & Song Society" Family Program) to 90 (Apple Hill Center for Chamber Music) to "no maximum age limit" (Emerald Coast Chamber Music Institute). For some, admission is strictly by audition; for others, all are welcome (though screened for level in most cases). You can study Lied in Vienna, practice yoga in Belgium, sing your heart out in Mandarin in China, play tennis in Peoria, or learn the Taubman Method at the Golandsky Institute in California. If you're between the ages of seven and 17, you can do it all (and more) at once at a camp in Upstate New York, which describes its program thusly: "Co-ed private performing arts individual choice program; classical & jazz music, theater, dance, visual arts, film & video, circus, magic, computer, sports, fitness, waterfront, skateboard, rock & roll, horseback riding."

Tuition ranges from full scholarship to close to five figures, with options for resident, commuter, auditor, and, in the case of our virtual entries, cyberhuman. The big guns with huge enrollments—Tanglewood and Interlochen come immediately to mind—continue to nurture the young geniuses who are tomorrow's (and in some cases today's) superstars, but there are many small, more intimately focused programs as well. Consider Classic Lyric Arts France, which has a mere ten students among its four teachers and is located in the south of France's Périgord region (known for its fois gras and truffles). Sign me up!
