On April 12th I read,



"And our very problems, then, are merely situations that confront us with the opportunity for greater self-expression." Then I turned to the article by Murphy the human whisperer with his favorite human, Bob Luckin, "Your voice is a very important part of All That Is... Your experiences and message matter."

Seeing the opportunity in a supposed problem and making it matter usually comes as hindsight. My life has been scattered with many unique opportunities for growth. I recently shared some of these with family members in a Mini-Memoir. I headed it with, "Beware the judge who would say, 'This is she...having read one experience.' Members in attendance voted in support of Reverend Joe as a candidate for our senior minister position here at Center for Spiritual Living St George.




He and his wife, Julie, also come to us with about 13 years of *Science of Mind and Spirit* practice and perspective. The timing of having Charles'
