

other law. Nothing herein shall prevent Madison County from issuing bonds under any existing act as well as under this act.

SEC. 11. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with this act are hereby repealed. Conflicting acts repealed.

SEC. 12 This act shall be in force from and after its ratification.

CHAPTER 101

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT CARNIVALS AND OTHER TENT SHOWS FROM EXHIBITING IN THE TOWN OF BAILEY, NASH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

SECTION 1. That no carnival or other tent show shall be allowed to exhibit in the town of Bailey, Nash County. No carnival in Bailey.

SEC. 2. That any person violating the provisions of this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not exceeding fifty dollars or imprisoned not more than thirty days. Violation misdemeanor; penalty.

SEC. 3. That this act shall be in force from and after its ratification.

Ratified this the 13th day of February, A.D. 1925.

CHAPTER 102

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MADISON COUNTY TO ISSUE BONDS FOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF:

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of Madison County shall put the road from Barnard to the Anderson Branch Schoolhouse in a first-class state of repair.

SEC. 2. That the said board of county commissioners shall begin at the Anderson Branch Schoolhouse and construct a road, not less than fourteen feet in width and on a grade not to exceed eight per cent, from the Anderson Branch Schoolhouse through the Paw Paw section to and intersecting with the Little Pine Creek Road at Kalamazoo. Construction of road.

SEC. 3. That said board of county commissioners shall begin immediately upon the ratification of this act to construct a Construction another road.
