Father Rodrigue Bouchard was born in Lévi, Quebec. Ordained on October 6, 1958, he was appointed pastor of St. Claude for 2 terms: from July 1972 to October 1985 and from August 1997 to August 2003. Polemical, he enjoyed good discussions. He faithfully supported teachers in catechism classes. During both his terms of ministry at the parish he was well known for his love of summer and winter sport activities, mainly for his active participation in curling. His positive influence among youth was well appreciated.
