God's People Confess Their Faith: Heidelberg Catechism No. 31 Q. Why is Jesus called Christ, that is, Anointed?

A. Because He has been ordained by God the Father, and anointed with the Holy Spirit, to be our chief Prophet and Teacher, who has fully revealed to us the secret counsel and will of God concerning our redemption; our only High Priest, who by the one sacrifice of His body has redeemed us, and who continually intercedes for us before the Father; and our eternal King, who governs us by His Word and Spirit, and who defends and preserves us in the redemption obtained for us.

God Calls Us to Repentance: 2 Timothy 2:24-26

And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil, correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth, and they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will.

God's People Confess Their Sin

Our Father and our King, we come before You confessing we are sinners and rebels against Your holiness, Your law, and Your justice. Not only that, we have been shown grace upon grace, yet we have valued Your grace cheaply and poorly by our sluggishness to put to death the deeds and desires of the flesh. We are unfit to be called by Your Name. We confess we have not been as patient with others as You are with us. We confess we have tried to advance our own position at the expense of our neighbor. We confess we have not spoken the truth in love (and

often we haven't even spoken the truth!). We confess we have considered ourselves superior to others because our sins and "issues" are not as obvious as those of other people. Please forgive us, Holy Father. Make us to taste afresh the bounty of Your grace and - because of Your richness and kindness toward us in Christ - enable us to shudder at the thought of sinning against You not because we fear Hell, but because we loathe the thought of displeasing You. Hear us we pray for Jesus' sake.


