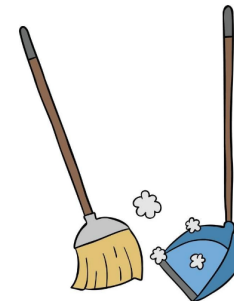
**TLC HAPPENINGS**
